THE FEAST OF MERCY / DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

In regards to the Feast of Divine Mercy Sunday, once after insisting to St. Faustina, "Do all you possibly can for this work of mercy," Jesus added: "My Heart rejoices on account of this feast." Our Lord's explicit desire was that this feast be celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Pope John Paul II declared at the canonization of St. Faustina that, the Second Sunday of Easter will be called 'Divine Mercy Sunday.' He went on to stress the suffering, death, burial, resurrection, and ascension of Christ, followed by the sending of the Holy Spirit - as being appropriate to this Feast of Divine Mercy on the Octave Day of Easter.

The Holy Father continued to say, it becomes clear why Jesus insisted that the sacred image of Himself as The Divine Mercy is to be venerated throughout the world in connection with the observance of this Sunday. The Holy Father said, "Jesus shows His hands and His side. He points to the wounds of the Passion, especially the wound in His Heart, the source from which flows the great wave of mercy." The two rays, Jesus Himself explained 'represent blood and water'.

Moreover, if the blood recalls the sacrifice of the Cross and the gift of the Eucharist, the water, in Johannine symbolism, represents not only Baptism but also the gift of the Holy Spirit."

"Divine Mercy reaches human beings through the Heart of Christ crucified: 'Tell, My daughter, [all people] that I am Love and Mercy itself [personified]' Jesus asked Sr. Faustina. Christ pours out this mercy on humanity through the sending of the Spirit who, in the Trinity, is the Person of Love. And is not mercy love's 'second name' understood in its deepest and most tender aspect, in its ability to take upon itself the burden of any need and, especially, in its most immense capacity for forgiveness?"

Jesus we trust in You!

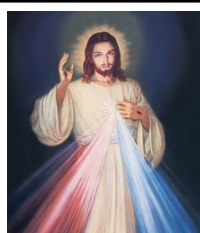


CONSECRATION TO THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS

THE HOLY EUCHARIST NEVER STOPS INSPIRING

EUCCHARISTIC MIRCLE OF SOKÓLKA, POLAND

On October 12, 2008, a consecrated Host fell out of the hands of a priest while he was distributing Holy Communion. He picked it up and placed it in a vessel filled with water, in the tabernacle. After Mass, the vessel containing the host was placed in a safe place in the sacristy. On October 19, 2008, after opening this vessel one could clearly see a red stain on the Host that had fallen, which with the naked eye immediately gave the impression of being a bloodstain. On October 29, 2008, the vessel containing the Host was transferred to the tabernacle of the chapel of the rectory. The next day the Host was removed from water contained in the vessel and placed on a corporal inside the tabernacle. On January 7, 2009, the sample of the Host was taken and examined independently by two professionals in histopathology at the University of Medicine in Bialystok, Poland.

"At first I was convinced that it was a blood clot" - said professor Sobaniec-Lotowska. But the truth was much more surprising! The two scientists of Bialystok, who for their own independent investigations, made use of the most modern optical microscopes and the transmission electronic microscope, have reached the same conclusion (Professor Sulkowski, did not know that the sample which he was examining came from a Host): The sample examined was neither a clot, nor blood...it was human cardiac muscle tissue still alive. And, something even more incredible, it was cardiac muscle with typical indications of the final phase that precedes death."
