

Jenks at Memorial

In a game played in tough, wet conditions, the Trojans showed no sign Thursday night of legursuit of another 6A State Championship as they trounced the hapless Memorial Chargers Stadium.

The victory gave Jenks it 15th win in a row and its 75th win in 80 district games.

Freddie Carolina shined in the conditions as he rushed for 173 yards and 3 touchdowns on 1 two quarters of play. He scored on runs of 11, 33, and 24 yards to put Jenks ahead 27-0 at

Jenks had a total of 267 yards on the ground and RB Renard Johnson added 98 yards on 15 TD's. Memorial gained only 59 yards on 43 attempts and dropped to 2-4 overall and 0-3 in

Jenks' other TD was scored by TE Jacob Laptad on a 50-yard pass from reserve QB Nick Sid

Memorial's top rusher was Devin Reed with 35 yards on 11 carries. The Chargers were able quarter scoreless streak in the third quarter when QB Steve Hamilton connected with WR R. 73-yard TD. The extra point attempt failed.
