Replacing Existing Curtains

Use the following steps when replacing existing curtains:

- ✓ Review the guidelines for measuring and recording requirements for replacement stage curtains.
- ✓ Fax us the information you have obtained, and a quote by return fax is yours.

MEASURING STAGE CURTAINS

Before proceeding with measuring, check the existing installation for adequate masking and proper lapping of the curtains at the center and sides.

Now is the time to find out if there is a discrepancy between the existing stage layout and that which may be preferred by those who utilize the space.

Use metal measuring tapes only.

WIDTH

Measure the width of each section of track from end to end.

Be sure to measure each half *separately*.

Traversing curtains should be measured in the closed position.

HEIGHT

Measure each floor length curtain from the top of the curtain to the floor (or from the eye or carrier pendant).

To reduce wear, stage curtains should ride 1" above the floor.

TIPS:

It's sometimes difficult to get a full height measurement for particularly high curtains.

A heavy-duty safety pin, hooked through the end of a metal tape and pinned through the rope at pulley end, is helpful in getting tape to top of curtain for an accurate measurement.

Place a binder clip on the metal tape at the estimated height a border curtain. This will allow you to more accurately measure the correct height once you get the end of the tape to the top of the curtain
