The Heavy Equipment Operator will be directly accountable to the Transportation Management and under the general supervision of the Tribal Administrator for the performance of assigned duties and responsibilities. This job is a full-time seasonal, non-exempt

#### **Qualifications:**

- Has an In-depth knowledge of road construction, material compaction, excavating and backfilling trenches, concrete forming, rip-rap stabilization, pile driving and rockery wall construction, culvert installation and dirt work construction practices.
- Operates full range of heavy construction equipment in safe efficient manner (i.e., front end loaders, excavators, track dozers, rollers, graders, wheel backhoes, and cranes.)
- Ability to understand and obey laws and regulations
- Ability to work as a team member.
- Operate a full range of heavy construction equipment, performing various tasks in difficult environments.
