Have a look at Vocab Ninja for daily words. What are the words? Can you look for their definitions? Can you put these words into written or verbal sentences?

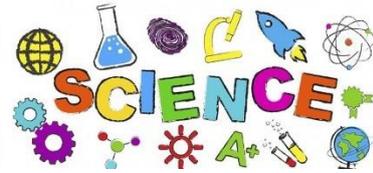
