

ORDINANCE NO 745.

An ordinance to amend section one, of Ordinance No. 744, providing for the issuing of bonds of the city of Garnett, Anderson, ^{county} Kansas, for the purpose of improving the electric lighting and water plant, now owned by said city, furnishing lights and power and water to the inhabitants of the city of Garnett, Kansas, to the amount of Sixty-five Thousand Dollars.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and board of Commissioners of the city of Garnett, Kansas:

Section 1. That Section 1 of ordinance ~~number~~ No 744 be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 1. That the negotiable coupon bonds of the city of Garnett, Kansas, to the aggregate amount of Sixty-five Thousand (\$65,000.00) dollars be and the same are hereby authorized and ordered to be issued, for the purpose of providing funds to improve the electric lighting and water plant now owned and operated by said city, and furnishing lights and power and water to the inhabitants of said city, ^{of} Garnett, Kansas. Said bonds shall bear the date of ~~July~~ July 1, 1918, and shall be ~~in~~ 65 in number and numbered from one (1) to sixty-five (65) inclusive and of the denomination of one thousand ^{dollars} (\$1,000.00) ~~each~~; and shall be due and payable absolutely twenty-five years from the date thereof, or, ^{at} the option of the city of Garnett, Kansas, at any interest paying date after July 1, 1933; said bonds shall bear interest at the rate of five per cent (5%) per annum payable semi-annually on the first day of January and July in each year, which interest payments shall be evidenced by proper coupons attached to each bond and both principal and interest shall be payable at the office of the State Treasurer, Topeka, Kansas.

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the time required by law from its passage and approval and publication in the official paper of said city.
