Provider Services

As of June 30th 2024 Great Plains Child Care Resource and Referral had a total of 586 Technical Assistance visits with Providers with 175 of those being unduplicated. Subjects range from Room Arrangement to Behavior and Guidance. A total of 448 Provider Visits were made throughout Southwest Oklahoma by staff. Great Plains Staff also facilitated over twenty formal professional development opportunities for child care providers in Southwest Oklahoma.





GPCCRR Road Trip

From October 1-30th Great Plains Child Care Resource & Referral visited over 80 providers spanning 15 counties on the annual GPCCRR Road Trip. Each provider signed up for the visit and received numerous resources for their facility.



Al's Pals

Great Plains Child Care Resource & Referral facilitated five Al's Pals Social Emotional Curriculum Trainings for a total of 60 hours of training with over 165 providers provided the training and resources to implement within their facilities. Providers received fall up visits to assist with implementation.
