

ABSENTEE VOTING

IF YOU'RE OVER 60 OR CAN'T BE AT THE POLLS ON ELECTION DAY, YOU CAN VOTE BY MAIL, OR IN PERSON IN YOUR CLERK'S OFFICE.

VOTE BY MAIL

1. Complete the absentee voter application obtained from your clerk, or on line at www.casscountydems.com Mail or deliver it to your clerk.
2. When your ballot comes in the mail, fill it out and return it by mail or deliver it to your clerk before 8pm on election day; or you can take it to the polls on election day.

VOTE IN PERSON AT YOUR CLERK'S OFFICE

1. Call your clerk and make an appointment to vote in their office. The list of clerks is on www.casscountydems.com
2. If you already have a completed absentee voter application take it with you, or fill out one at the clerk's office.
3. Vote a regular ballot and give it to your clerk.
