



## INSTRUMENTAL TUITION PROGRAMME AT BISAK

The instrumental music tuition programme was introduced at BISAK in September 2013 and is run by a UK trained, professional instrumental teacher. Tuition is offered in piano, clarinet, flute, saxophone, violin and viola

### TUITION INFORMATION

Pupils enrolled on the programme receive 1 x 30 minute lesson per week individually or in a small group (maximum 3) throughout each term with a minimum of 30 lessons delivered throughout the academic year. Please note that pupils receiving lessons during the school day will have their time slot rotated to ensure they do not miss the same curriculum lesson each week. This rotational extraction system is used in the UK for instrumental music instruction in schools and upon which the BISAK programme is based.

### CURRICULUM

Lessons are tailored to the individuals' needs and requirements. Western notation is taught and lessons include technique, repertoire, improvisation, theory and aural skills. Exams may be taken following the Associated Board of the Royal Schools of Music (ABRSM) graded syllabus (Grades 1-8) in Bahrain at an additional charge. ### ENROLMENT

To enroll your child in the programme, please complete the Instrumental Music Tuition Enrolment Form (available from Reception and the Music Department) and return it to Reception clearly marked for the attention of Music Administrator, Instrumental Music Programme Enrolment. Please retain a copy for your reference. On receipt of the Enrolment Form we will advise you if your child has secured a place on the programme or has been placed on the waiting list.

### PAYMENT & FEES

Following successful enrolment, an invoice, tuition agreement and timetable will be issued. Fees are paid in termly blocks and payment must be returned to the Finance office prior to the first lesson.  
Individual lessons = SAR1400 per term  
Group lessons = SAR930 per term

***Please note that refunds or replacement lessons will not be provided for timetabled lessons missed due to student illness or emergency school closure.***

### INSTRUMENTS & EQUIPMENT

It is essential that your child has access to the relevant instrument for daily practice as it is understood that this is a prerequisite for success on a musical instrument. The school has a limited stock of instruments and it is therefore recommended that parents purchase instruments for their child. We operate an instrument hire/purchase scheme for woodwind (flute, clarinet and saxophone). All pupils must bring their music and instrumental notebook to each lesson for teacher's notes and guidance on practise. A music stand for practise at home is also required.

Please note that due to the size and weight of the saxophone, lessons are not available in this instrument to pupils under the age of 9.
