

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 200 FOR ESTABLISHING AND LEVYING THE RATE OF TAXATION FOR THE YEAR 2014 ON ALL PROPERTY WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF INNSBROOK, WARREN COUNTY, MISSOURI AND PROVIDING FOR THE EXTENSION OF SAID TAXES ON THE BOOKS OF THE COLLECTOR BY THE COUNTY CLERK OF WARREN COUNTY, MISSOURI

WHEREAS, the office of the Warren County Clerk issued a revised set of valuations for the Village of Innsbrook after the adoption of Ordinance No. 200; and

WHEREAS, due to the revised valuations it was necessary to hold another public hearing with notice placed in the Warren County Record on August 21, 2014;

WHEREAS, a public hearing was duly published and held on August 28, 2014 to set the tax rate for the fiscal year 2014 for the Village of Innsbrook from revised figures provided by the Warren County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, at said public hearing all interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard and were heard.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF INNSBROOK, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: There is hereby levied on all property (Real Estate) within the corporate limits of the Village of Innsbrook, Warren County, Missouri, a tax rate for the year of 2014 of **(\$0.1267)** on the One Hundred Dollar (\$100.00) assessed valuation as shown on the assessment books of the Warren County Clerk and certified to by the County Clerk.

SECTION 2: There is hereby levied on all property (Personal) within the corporate limits of the Village of Innsbrook, Warren County, Missouri, a tax rate for the year 2014 of Zero Cents (\$0.00) on the One Hundred Dollar (\$100.00) assessed valuation as shown on the assessment books of the Warren County Clerk and certified to by the County Clerk.


SECTION 3: The collection of all taxes so extended shall be enforced in the same manner and under the same rules and regulations as may be provided by law for collection and enforcing the payment of State and County taxes.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Chairman.
