Regular Meeting & Public Tax hearing----September 2, 1986

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, ATTENDANCE D. L. Taylor at 7:00 A.M. Other Grand County Water Conservancy District members present were Georgia Hamblin, Smith, and Stan Baker.

Grand County Special Service District members present were D. L. Taylor, Dan Holyoak, and William D. McDougald.

Others present were Janie Walker, Jerry Walker, Dale Pierson and Roberta Highland.

Roberta read the minutes of the meeting of August MINUTES 19, 1986. After calling for corrections or additions, the Chair declared the minutes approved as read.

Dale explained the reason for the public tax hear- PUBLIC TAX ing was that the notice had been deemed inadequate, and the HEARING rate will be no different than the one passed at the previous public hearing.

After a short discussion, Dan Holyoak moved the GCSSWD TAX Grand County Special Service Water rate be set at .000349 RATE for Debt Service and .0000009 for Maintenance and Operation. Bill McDougald seconded. MOTION CARRIED.

Stan Baker moved the Grand County Water Conservan- GCWCD TAX cy District certified tax rate be set at .000325 for debt RATE service. John Smith seconded. MOTION CARRIED.

The $\,$ rates and methods of delivering water to $\,$ the $\,$ PROPOSED GOLF golf course were discussed. Georgia Hamblin asked what COURSE happened if all the water was sold and someone with Moab DEVELOPMENT Irrigation Co. stock requested water. Dale told her his understanding of the contract was that Moab Irrigation stock holders had a first priority only to available water. letter of intent to purchase enough water from the Golf Course Association was requested.

Dale reported there was a possibility of another $^{\mathrm{LEAK}}$ IN THE LAKE leak in the reservoir. He thinks perhaps there was a leak and the blanket had slumped into the hole and sealed There is a slump in the area and he and Mark Page is going to look at it this week. He is of the opinion that excavation is not necessary.
