

**Fliegel, Neva**

Neva C. Fliegel, 94, of Sebewaing, died Saturday afternoon, January 4, 2003, at Covenant Health Care, Harrison, in Saginaw following a lengthy illness. She was born February 21, 1908 in Chaska, Minnesota, daughter of the late Herbert A. and Caroline (Kemp) Fliegel. She was a graduate of Central Michigan University in Mt. Pleasant and taught special education in Ionia for three years. She also was a taxi cab driver in Dearborn for 20 years.
