## Clinic Visits and COVID-19 Pandemic

We follow the recommendations of the CDC and AAP (American Academy of Pediatrics): well visits and routine immunizations should continue during the COVID-19 pandemic, with special emphasis given to seeing children 2 years old and younger for routine well visits and vaccines.

## 1. Well Child Visits and Immunizations

- You can come to your appointment as usual.
- It's important to continue to immunize your child against diseases. And some vaccinations are difficult to, or cannot, be caught-up later.
- Well visits are being scheduled for both MORNINGS and AFTERNOONS

## 2. Keeping the Clinic Clean and Safe

- Online check-in
- Wait in vehicle, one patient/parent brought in clinic at a time, to maintain social distancing
- Bring/wear your masks to clinic appointment (our staff will have masks on too)
- We are checking everyone's temperature (patients, parent, our staff, etc) before patient is seen
- Sanitizing thoroughly between every appointment
- \*\*\*Limit accompanying family members to only one caregiver & the patient\*\*\*

## 3. Video Visits for if you are SICK

- All sick visits are being done by Telemedicine (video visit) now.
- Video visits allow you to have face-to-face consultations with your usual doctor from home, without the need to come to clinic in-person.
- All you need is a smartphone, tablet, or computer. Nothing to download.
- When it's time to start your video visit you will receive a text or email with a link. It's that simple!
- Video visits are covered the same as in-clinic appointments by most insurance plans
