

ORDINANCE NO. 1975 - 9

AN ORDINANCE DISANNEXING UNPLATTED CONTIGUOUS TERRIORITY FROM THE TOWN OF CLOVERDALE, INDIANA.

Be it ordained by the board of Trustees of the Town of Cloverdale, Indiana, as follows:

Section 1. That the following described unplatted contiguous territory within the Town of Cloverdale, Putnam County, Indiana, be, and hereby is, disannexed from the Town of Cloverdale, Indiana, to-wit:

Situate in the State of Indiana, County of Putnam and being a part of the southwest fractional quarter of Section 6, Township 12 North, Range 3 West of the Second Principal Meridian, more particularly described to-wit:

Beginning 1316.7 feet North of the Southwest corner of the southwest fractional quarter of Section 6, Township 12 North, Range 3 West; thence North 214.5 feet; thence East 406.23 feet; thence South 214.5 feet; thence west 406.23 feet to the point of beginning, containing 2 acres, more or less.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, publication and certification according to law.
