Rinn has always been about reaching out to the larger community, and we have plans for that this summer. Mark your calendar for the following events in coming up in the Firestone/Fredrick area:



Cowboy Fellowship at Boulder County Fair!




Boulder County Fairgrounds Indoor Arena Sunday August 11, 2024 at 10:30 AM

Did you know that you can tie your King Sooper's loyalty card to Rinn UMC, and the church will get a contribution every time you use it?



- Arrange on trays found in the kitchen


- Napkins, small plates, cups, coffee carafes, lemonade pitchers, creamer, sugar, stir stick can all be found in the kitchen
