

Safety Procedures

The Studio Atlanta Dance is committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for our students, staff and teachers. Our safety measures can reduce but not eliminate the risk of COVID-19 transmission. Our policies are subject to change due to updated CDC and state guidelines.

All Studios will have nightly cleaning as well as frequently touched surfaces being wiped down by staff throughout the day. Bathrooms cleaned frequently throughout the day.

- Hand sanitizer in lobby and in all classrooms. Disinfecting wipes available for teacher use in all classrooms.
- Floors will be cleaned regularly.
- Only students will be allowed in the building. Drop off and pick up will take place at the door to the facility. The lobby will not be open for parent seating.
- Temperatures will be taken upon arrival. Parents should not leave until this is done. If the student has a temp of 100.4 degrees or higher, they will be sent home immediately.
- Dancers should arrive wearing their dance attire.
- All uniforms will be purchased by pre-order only. The boutique will not be open for shopping.
- Visitors will not be allowed in the building.
- Staff and teachers will be required to wear masks at all times.
- Dancer will be required to wear masks at all times. Use of face coverings is an important way to help mitigate the spread of COVID-19.
- Social distancing marking will be utilized at all times during class. There will be no back and forth across the floor.
- Anyone showing signs of illness will be isolated until they can leave the building.
- If we have a confirmed case of COVID-19 in a faculty or staff member or student, the building will be shut down for cleaning. Those who have been in contact with the infected person will be notified to the best of our ability.
- If a COVID-19 case prompts temporary closure, we will move to virtual classes until the studio can reopen.
