



Give God First Fruits

He [Jacob] had a dream in which he saw a stairway resting on the earth with its top reaching to heaven, and the angels of God were "ascending and descending" on it.

Genesis 28:12





There above it stood the LORD, and he said: I am the LORD, the God of your [grand]father Abraham and the God of Isaac. I will give you and your descendants the land on which you are lying. ... I am with you and will watch over you wherever you go, and I will bring you back to this land. I will NOT leave you until I have done what I have promised you."


In the past God spoke to our forefathers through the prophets ... but in these days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, and through whom he made the universe.

Hebrews 1:1-4 "Barnabas"








3. Set aside a <u>tenth</u> of your time, talents and treasurers to the glory of God!







