- 9. How many feet before a turn must you signal your intention to turn?
- 10. What lane position should you position your vehicle when preparing to make a right hand turn?
- 11. Which lane should your vehicle be in after turning left into a two lane, one-way street?
- 12. When must headlamps and taillights be lighted?
- 13. Does an oncoming vehicle have the right ow way when you are making a left turn at an uncontrolled intersection?
