6. If two vehicles are stopped at right angles at an uncontrolled intersection, which vehicle has the right-of-way?
7. Under what conditions may you pass another vehicle on the RIGHT?
8. Name two instances when it is illegal to pass on the LEFT.
9. How many feet before a turn must you signal your intention to turn?
10. What lane position should you position your vehicle when preparing to make a right hand turn?
11. Which lane should your vehicle be in after turning left into a two lane, one-way street?
12. When must headlamps and taillights be lighted?
13. Does an oncoming vehicle have the right of way when you are making a left turn at an uncontrolled intersection?
14. How may you proceed at an intersection that has a green arrow in combination with a red light? This is usually for right turning vehicles.
