This FCSA sanctioned match will be held at the Long Range Alley Gun Club, approximately 15 miles south of Shreveport. If you have never been to LRAGC before there are directions to the range on the FCSA & SCSC website (1moa.org) & (sc50sc.com).

The range will be open Friday for sighting rifles at about 0930 till 1630 pm. Sight-in targets will be available (typically clay pigeons or White Boards on stakes) with lots of spotting help available as well. The 200 yard range is available to assist in getting rifles on paper before moving to 1,000 yard range if needed.

600 Yard Match:

The 600 yard fun shoot will be held on Saturday afternoon after the match.

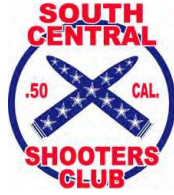

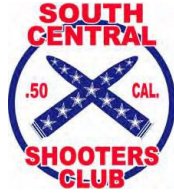
Targets & Safety Meeting:

We are asking all competitors to be at the range by 0730 hours on Saturday morning. The Shooters safety meeting (mandatory) is Saturday morning at 0730 hours. Shooters hopefully will know their shooting assignments at this time. After the meeting all folks are ask to go to the pits and help put up Targets. Folks that are working the pits for the First Relay will stay in pits and shooters will get back to 1000 yard shooting line. Given past attendance we anticipate we will be shooting at least four separate relays on both days of competition. All competitors are required to take their turn in the pits unless arrangements are made for paid / volunteer target pullers. There will be a group picture taken after the safety meeting on Saturday morning.

Each afternoon there is a need for people to help put up the Targets when we are finished shooting. Please take the time to help with the clean up of the targets so no one gets left with the "WORK". Thank you.

There will be a SCSC Club get together on Friday evening immediately after range is closed down (weather permitting). This is a "bring your own meat and whatever" and everyone joins in, good eats and good times. The after shooting "Get-Togethers" have been a big success in the past, so hopefully we will have a good time this year.
