

Below are instructions to set up the Microsoft Edge browser in order to access the licensing website going forward. Please apply these changes.



Setup of IE mode in EDGE for use with NMRLD MyLicense e-Government website


 Open the Edge browser and click the 3 dot menu on the top right of the window




 Find the Default Brower menu and click on it. From there change the "Allow Sited to be Reloaded in Internet Explorer mode" drop down field and change the value to "Allow". Then click the Restart button to restart your browser.




- When the browser restarts go to the appropriate renewal website.
