John E. "Jake" Ezack, 79, of Harbor Beach passed away Saturday, Sept. 30, 2000, in Autumnwood of Deckerville following a short illness. He was born March 6, 1921, in Harbor Beach to the late Edward and Agnes Ezack. He sailed on the Great Lakes working for the U.S. Steel Co., and he was a retired employee of the Active Industries, Inc., of Elkton, retiring in 1984 after many years of employment.
