Subj: NDIA Violates Its Mission Statement by Advocating SAE/EIA-748E Earned Value Management System

Dear Hon. NDIA Pres. David Norquist:

The NDIA has violated its own mission statement by requesting the SAE International G-47 Systems Engineering (SE) Committee to approve draft EIA-748E Earned Value Management System (EVMS) Standard (EIA-748E).

As stated in my letter, Subj: Assign SE Experts to Salvage Draft EIA-748E EVMS Standard, dated August 12:

- 1. The SAE International G-47 SE Committee completed its first ballot on the draft EIA-748E.
- 2. EIA-748E is not within the scope of SAE International's policies or of the Systems Management Council Organization and Operating Procedures (SMC) because,
- 3. The SMC procedures specify that its standards contain specific performance requirements and are used for: (1) design standards, (2) parts standards, (3) *minimum performance standards*, (4) *quality*, and (5) other areas conforming to *broadly accepted engineering practices or specifications* for a material, product, process, procedure, or test method.

The NDIA mission statement, which follows, includes "advocate for best practices."

Elsewhere, NDIA states its mission: NDIA shall serve in a leadership role by setting high ethical standards and practices for the industry.

As stated in previous letters, EIA-748 is a business standard, not a SE standard. EIA-748E contains no broadly accepted engineering best practices or SE best practices. If the NDIA chooses to develop a national SE standard and promote its claim to be the "world's trusted leader in professional national security and defense associations," then the NDIA SE Division should draft it, not the NDIA Integrated Program Management Division.

EVM is within the scope of integrated program/project management, not SE. So, the NDIA should:

- 1. Withdraw its submittal to the SAE International G-47 SE Committee and
- 2. Submit any draft EVMS standard, with best business practices for EVM, to an appropriate approving organization such as the Project Management Institute or ISO. Failure to do so would be a violation of

NDIA's mission statement and would disqualify EIA-748 from being a Voluntary Consensus Standard (VCS) per OMB criteria.

Of course, the HASC, SASC, DoD and OMB should take actions to revise statutes, policies, training, compliance reviews, staffing, software licenses, and consultants to recognize that EIA-748 is not a VCS, as recommended in other letters and white papers.
