Bloomfield Police Department Monthly Report for December 2019

This is the monthly report for the Month of December 2019 from the Bloomfield Police Department. It is the police department's goal to keep the citizens of Bloomfield Township/Village informed as to the police department's activities, statistics, and community projects. It is very important that the citizens be aware of the various concerns that have and are occurring within our community.

On Wednesday, December 4th at approximately 12:22pm officers responded to a residence in the 900 block of Rose Drive for a disorderly person complaint. At the conclusion of the investigation 2 counts of bail jumping was referred to the Walworth County District Attorney's office for a 28-year-old female.

On Wednesday, December 4th at approximately 8:53pm officers executed a traffic stop on Hwy 120 for a speeding violation. At the conclusion of the traffic stop a 24-year-old male was issued a citation for the speeding violation. Additionally, a charge of operating a motor vehicle while revoked was forwarded to the Walworth County District Attorney's office.

On Saturday, December 7th at approximately 12:07am officers executed a traffic stop on Daisy Dr. in the area of Hyacinth Rd for a traffic violation. At the conclusion of the traffic stop a 29-year-old male was issued traffic citations for operating after suspension and operating a motor vehicle without insurance.

On Sunday, December 8th at approximately 1:47am officers discovered a suspicious vehicle parked at a closed business on Schaitel Road. At the conclusion of the investigation 41-year-old male was issued non-traffic citations for possession of marijuana and possession of drug paraphernalia. Additionally, the male was issued a traffic citation for operating without a valid driver's license.

On Sunday, December 8th at approximately 2:35am officers executed a traffic stop in the area of Hwy H and Schaitel Road. At the conclusion of the traffic stop a 29-year-old female was arrested for operating a motor vehicle while intoxicated 1st offense.

On Monday, December 9th at approximately 8:08pm officers responded to the 800 block of Eau Claire Road for a disorderly subject complaint. At the conclusion of the investigation a charge of disorderly conduct was forwarded to the Walworth County District Attorney's office for a 32-year-old female.

On Wednesday, December $11^{\rm th}$ at approximately 9:05pm officers responded to a residence in the 2400 block of Howard Drive for a criminal damage to property complaint. The complainant reported that person(s) unknown shot their vehicle multiple times with what appeared to be a bb/pellet gun causing damage to the body and windows to be broken. This incident remains under investigation.

On Wednesday, December 11th at approximately 10:59pm officers responded to the 2400 block of Howard Drive for a disorderly conduct complaint. At the conclusion of the investigation a 36-year-old female and a juvenile were issued non-traffic citations for disorderly conduct.

On Sunday, December 15th at approximately 12:09pm officers responded to the area of Daisy Drive and Camelia Road for a theft from motor vehicle complaint. The complainant reported that the vehicle window had been left open and that person(s) unknown entered the vehicle taking an item. This incident remains under investigation.

On Monday, December 16th at approximately 8:05am officers responded to the area of Bloomfield Road and Lyons Road for a vehicle in the ditch. At the conclusion of the investigation a 34-year-old male was issued traffic citations for driving too fast for conditions and operating a motor vehicle without insurance. Additionally, a charge of operating after revocation was forwarded to the Walworth County District Attorney's office.

On Wednesday, December 18th at approximately 12:45pm officers responded to the area of Clover Road near Glenwood Road for a vehicle versus pole personal injury crash. At the conclusion of the investigation a 28-year-old male was issued a traffic citation for inattentive driving.

On Saturday, December 21st at approximately 12:45am officers executed a traffic stop in the area of Mariondale Rd and Washington Road for a traffic violation. At the conclusion of the traffic stop a charge of operating after revocation was forwarded to the Walworth County District Attorney's office for a 32-year-old female driver.

On Sunday, December 22^{nd} at approximately 7:15pm officers responded to a residence in the 1500 block of Orchid Drive for a disorderly female. At the conclusion of the investigation a 27-year-old female was arrested and confined in the Walworth County Jail. A charge of disorderly conduct has been forwarded to the Walworth County District Attorney's office.

On Monday, December 23rd at approximately 7:46am officers responded to the area of Eastside Road and Hwy 50 for a single commercial motor vehicle roll over personal injury crash. At the conclusion of the investigation a 36-year-old male was issued traffic citations for deviation from designated lane, failure to secure load, and cellphone operation while driving a commercial motor vehicle. Eastside Road was closed for approximately 3.5 hours while until the vehicle load (gravel) was removed from the roadway.

On Wednesday, December 25th at approximately 4:15am officers responded to the 1200 block of Walnut Road for a disorderly conduct complaint. At the conclusion of the investigation a 46-year-old female was arrested and confined in the Walworth County Jail. A charge of disorderly conduct has been forwarded to the Walworth County District Attorney's office.

During the month of December 2019, the Bloomfield Police Department responded to 715 calls for service compared to 745 calls for service during the month of December 2018. During the month of December 2019, the police department affected 123 arrests for various violations of Bloomfield Municipal Ordinances and Wisconsin State Statutes compared 165 arrests during the month of December 2018.
