NEW BUSINESS: Ordinance #428 was approved on the first reading

Comm. Genz moved the approval of Ord. # 428 on the first reading; Comm. Wright seconded the motion as follows:

AN ORDINANCE # 428 TO AMEND ORDINANCE # 334 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF PORTABLE AND WADING POOLS, THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS AND REGISTRATION, TOGETHER WITH PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATIONS THEREOF, IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD, NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Winfield, County of Union, State of New Jersey, that WHEREAS, the Winfield Board of Health amended the words, terms, or phrases listed below for the purpose of this Ordinance shall be defined and interpreted; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Winfield, County of Union, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 9 of Ordinance No. 334 is hereby amended as follows:

- A) Every pool, including hot tubs, shall be maintained in cleaned and sanitary condition
- B) Any nuisance or hazard to health which may exist or develop in or in consequence of or in connection with any such swimming pool shall forthwith be abated and removed by the person in possession of such pool, upon receipt of notice from Health Official or other designated person so requiring.

SECTION 2. Any person who violates or neglects to comply with any provision of this chapter, or notice issued pursuant thereto, shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine not less than \$50 and not exceeding \$500 for each violation.

A separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

SECTION 3. Remains as said

If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall apply to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this ordinance shall remain valid and effective.

This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.
