CONTEST UPDATES: *Notes from the Chair:*

Purpose: To evaluate each contestant's preparation for employment and to recognize outstanding students for excellence and professionalism in the field of industrial motor controls.

Clothing: Acceptable work clothes, work boots, no jewelry (rings, watches, etc.), no school names displayed on any apparel

Safety requirements: Safety glasses (approved side shields must be worn if contestant wears corrective lenses), work gloves, Lockout lock and tagout tag.

Contestants are required to remain at the end of the contest to assist in tearing down project following judging.

Tools to be provided by contestant:

10" pump pliers, hacksaw with blade, Utility knife, 9" torpedo level, 6" long nose pliers, 4" flat head screwdriver, 4" Phillips head screwdriver, 6" flat head screwdriver, One terminal screwdriver, 8" diag. cut pliers, Tape measure, Tool pouch, Tool belt, wire stripper, ½" EMT bender, One VOM meter, 2014 NEC book, #2 pencils.
