Midwest USA Adult-Junior Doubles Championships Rules

Schedule: This is a USBC-certified (#10793) Adult-Junior scratch doubles bowling tournament. It is operated by Midwest USA Scholarship Tournaments, LLC. Greg Coulles, Director. **NEW DATE: Saturday, July 11, 2020** at Beaver-Vu Bowl 1238 N. Fairfield Rd., Beavercreek, OH 45432. 937.426.6771. **daytonbowling.com.**

Doors open at 9:30 AM. Check-in begins at 9:45 AM. Warm-ups at 10:50 AM. Tournament play begins about 11:00 AM Eastern time, subject to on-site adjustments. A team will consist of one adult bowler and one youth bowler. There are two divisions: a division for an adult bowler teamed with a youth bowler age 15-20 and a separate division for an adult bowler teamed with a youth bowler age 14 and under. The youth bowler's age on August 1, 2019 will be the determiner of division enrollment. NOTE: This is an "age-based" tournament, not a USBC membership-based tournament. A bowler age 20 and under (as defined) may participate as the youth bowler in this tournament even if that bowler has a USBC adult membership. Bowlers registered as a youth bowler may only earn scholarship (not cash) awards. The gender of either the adult or the youth bowler is NOT a consideration. A male may bowl with a male or female, or vice versa. Maximum allowed teams: TBA based on State of Ohio facility capacity requirements. If not stipulated by the State: 155 max. teams.

Format: Qualifying Round: Each team will bowl a Qualifying Round of four (4) games of regular tenpin bowling. 32 teams in the 15 & older division and 12 teams in the 14 & under division, based on total team Qualifying Round scores, will advance to the Championship Round (subject to change based on number of divisional entries). Ties for the final advancing Qualifying Round team will be broken by the high single game score rolled by a team.

Championship Round: The scores from the Qualifying Round will be dropped. All Championship Round games will be Baker games in which the youth bowler will bowl the even-numbered frames and the adult bowler the odd-numbered frames. Each team will bowl two (2) "Baker" games with each game bowled entirely on 1 lane, switching lanes on the pair after each game. The field will be cut after each 2 Baker game set based on the team's 2-game Baker total. There will be four (4), 2-game Baker sets in the 15 & older division and three (3), 2-game Baker sets in the 14 & under division. The number of teams that will advance after each Baker game set will be posted in the tournament office. Championship Round Placement: In both divisions, higher placement in the final tournament standings will be based on the scores rolled in final two (2) game Baker set in which a team participated. Ties: all ties for any advancement will be broken by a 9th/10th frame roll-off in which the adult bowler will bowl the 9th frame and the youth bowler the 10th frame.

Lane Pattern/Surface: The lane pattern will be posted at tournament check-in. Beaver-Vu Bowl has Brunswick ProLane synthetic lanes & textured synthetic approach surface.

Cost: The pre-paid (received before 5:00 PM, Friday, 7.10.20) entry fee is \$90.00 per team. Breakdown: Cost of bowling: \$35.00. Tournament expenses: 10.00. SMART \$cholarships for youth bowlers: \$45.00. Total pre-paid entry fee: \$90.00. Note: entries received after 5:00 PM, Friday, 7.10.20 will be charged an additional \$10.00 late processing fee. The closing date for entries is Saturday, July 11, 2020. Only paid entries will be accepted. Walk-ins will be accepted subject to lane availability. Phone calls & E-mails asking to reserve an unpaid spot with the intention to participate will not be honored.

General Rules: Abuse of equipment, foul or disruptive language, gestures, and/or unprofessional behavior by bowlers or spectators are cause for the non-refundable dismissal from participation or attendance at this tournament. All bowling equipment must meet USBC specifications. The use of powder or any foreign substance (including rosin & Easy Slide) on shoes, the approach, or on the facility floor or carpet is not permitted. USBC regulations regarding altering a ball surface will be enforced. Only participating bowlers and officials are permitted in the bowling area. The Tournament Manager has the right to refuse any entry. The bowler, by voluntary participation in the event, acquiesces to the final authority of the Tournament Manager to make necessary on-site changes and to interpret and enforce all rules, regulations, and procedures. Any unforeseen or not described situation(s) will be regulated by USBC rules with interpretative judgment guided by the best interest of youth bowling and this event.

Awards: The youth bowler on no fewer than one of six teams (1:6) in each division will be awarded a SMART scholarship. In addition, the top 4-game series rolled during the Qualifying Round by a boy and a girl in each age division will receive a \$50 SMART scholarship (4 awards x \$50 = \$200 total). Optional high game scholarship jackpots will be available for youth bowlers. Optional adult brackets and/or high game jackpots will be separately available.

100% of all collected scholarship funds & awards for youth bowlers will be awarded and sent to the SMART Program for management and dispersal (Acct. #8871). Information about the SMART Program is available on bowl.com.

SAFETY POLICIES AT THE ADULT-JUNIOR DOUBLES CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Midwest USA Adult-Junior Doubles Championships Saturday, July 11, 2020

Bowlers & Spectators:

As a condition to operate the Adult-Junior Doubles Championships, we must be in compliance with the State of Ohio's <u>Consumer, Retail, Services, Entertainment</u>, <u>Restaurant & Bar</u>, and <u>General Non-Contact Sports</u> mandates along with the operation policies of Beaver-Vu Bowl. Below, please find the attendance policies in effect at this tournament.

BOWLERS

- 1. "NO-TOUCH" RULE IS IN EFFECT: All individuals must avoid physical contact with others before, during and after the event in the facility. This includes high-fives, handshakes, hugs, fist bumps, etc.
- 2. **EQUIPMENT:** Equipment (balls, shoes, towels, accessories items, including beverages and food, etc.) may not be shared with anyone. Only touch and use your own personal equipment.
- 3. **MAXIMUM PARTICIPATION:** Per bowling center policy, the maximum number of bowlers on a lane will be four (4). Eight (8) bowlers on a pair. 1 unused pair of lanes will exist between each used pair of lanes in this league. Maximum number of doubles teams: 64. Details: 16 used pairs x 4 teams on a pair = 64 teams.
- 4. **LANE ASSIGNMENTS:** To significantly reduce bowler and spectator movement, Bowlers will bowl all 3 games of the Qualifying Round on the same pair of lanes. Lanes will be arbitrarily pre-assigned by league management.

SPECTATORS

1. **SOCIAL DISTANCING:** Spectators must maintain six-foot social distancing. **To assist in compliance with this regulation**, the center reserves the right to allow only one (1) spectator per bowler in the bowling center.

BOWLERS AND SPECTATORS

- 1. FACE MASKS: Face masks are allowed for bowlers and are STRONGLY encouraged for spectators.
- 2. **SYMPTOMS:** Anyone experiencing symptoms of illness will not be admitted into the center. Anyone experiencing illness symptoms must stay home. The center reserves the right to take a no-touch temperature reading of all athletes and spectators. Anyone with a fever or refusing to submit to a temperature reading, if requested, will be asked to leave.
- 3. **SANITATION:** Hands should be sanitized on a regular basis either with soap and water (20 sec.) or with hand sanitizer located throughout the center and in the tournament office at no charge.
- 4. **ADMISSION**: All bowlers & spectators will be admitted into the center through the front door. The side doors will be unavailable to admit people and only available to exit the facility. There is no admission charge.

NOTICES

The State of Ohio can amend their mandates of bowling center and sport operation at will and without notice. We must comply with their changing mandates as a condition to conduct this tournament and to operate the bowling center. **Any additional or revised State mandates will be announced on-site.** Please exercise sound judgement and respect all safety rules for everyone's benefit.
