President, Ward called the meeting to order.

**Announcements:**

Our newest members are Andrew and Maureen Swaney from Montross . Bob Bailey won 1st place with his 1947 Ford Super Deluxe at the Fredericksburg AACA car show. We lost a wonderful member with the passing of Cecil Posey. Several club members traveled to Fredericksburg to pay their respects. Ward said he always appreciated his conversations with Cecil and enjoyed his Nova which reminded him of his family car. Ward announced we have several changes in the club. Brent and Sherry have resigned their positions of Secretary and Car Show committee chair. Ward said I've always tried to be open and honest with everyone in the club and I think I have. It has never been in my character to be underhanded. Ward remarked that Brent and Sherry had done a number of remarkable things that have benefited our club.

**Note to minutes:**

He doesn't recall saying to Charlene "Charlene, I just can't help that" in the By-Laws discussion. He does not remember reading, from the Franklin's letter on the 501C.4 tax status "Concerns about club not meeting IRS requirements to maintain a non-profit status", that they may resign from the club depending on the outcome. On the national dues subject, Ward said the club would not pick up the national dues for the rest of the year for any new member. The AACA will charge half for new member dues and the club will only waive the NNK Region dues for new members.

- Treasurer's report - Last month's starting balance for checking was \$12,658.91. Receipts were \$5, 858.45. Expenses were \$1,303.18. The ending balance for checking was \$17, 214.18. The CD value is \$10,132.91. Treasurer's report was read, motioned to approve, seconded, and approved.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

Car Show - Ward and Bob felt the car show ran very smoothly this year. Brent and Sherry hosted a car judging class at their garage which was a major contributing factor to the successful show. Ward has stored the remaining trophies in his basement and has delivered 2 of the 3 trophies for winners who left early. The 3rd will be presented to winner from Mechanicsville at future Roma cruise-in. Members who did not have their cars judged and wish to receive a plaque should submit their names to Ward NLT the next meeting. We will discuss the comments submitted from this year's car show at next month's meeting.

Scholarship Proposal- Ward submitted a scholarship proposal for a graduating student from the Northern Neck Technical center to the Ladies Auxiliary Committee at the board meeting for their consideration in determining charities to support.

Ward announced that the club needs to fill a board member position and we are looking for a replacement secretary.

Patriotic Palooza – King George Parks and Recreation requested our club bring cars to their event at Barnesfield Park on June 27th at 5:00 PM. Please submit a registration form if you plan to attend.

Legislative Alert - Please Contact Your Member of Congress to Request Support for 704 Legislation (HR 704)which has been introduced in the U.S. House of Representatives to prohibit the sale of E15 (gasoline that is 15% ethanol). Ethanol, especially in higher concentrations such as E15, can cause damage to older vehicles. Ward will resend the information to all members.

Colonial Beach Car Show – The annual Father's Day car show is Sunday, June 21st on Town Hill in Colonial Beach from 10:00AM – 4:00 PM. Let's support the Colonial Beach Cruisers car club.

Cars for the Cure – The car show to benefit the Juve-
