SOCIAL / HOUSING

- More housing near jobs, less commuting.
- Development of the Eco-town at Northstowe on an old airfield. Sustainably built housing, 40% affordable.
- Area on the edge of Cambridge suffers from urban sprawl and counterurbanisation. New housing, business parks, science parks and retail outlets put pressure on the countryside. But do provide jobs and services for people in the nearby rural areas.

ENVIRONMENT

- · Maintain the green belt around Cambridge.
- Maintain the green infrastructure such as the fens and country parks.
- Maintain the built heritage to encourage tourism.
- Preserve habitats such as hedgerows to maintain biodiversity.
- Maintain the distinctive landscapes of the fens in the north and the chalklands in the south.

ECONOMY

- Develop a hierarchy of rural, centres from minor to group villages with increasing numbers of facilities and services.
- · Retain the rural character of villages.
- Develop renewable energy sources (wind and solar) but understand the delicate balance between sustainable energy and environmental damage.
- Improve the transport infrastructure and services to promote jobs in the tertiary sector, research and development, science and pharmaceuticals.
