Gravel has been spread in front and around the east and west sides of the labyrinth. Trees (6) have been planted. As donations are received, more trees will be placed. We have also planted shrubs and flower bushes and surrounded the area with gravel. Adobe dedication plaques are now in place in the labyrinth courtyard and placement of plaques continue. Once all these are in place, merchants who have supported our project, will also be acknowledged. Each outlying mission will have its own mission statue displayed when funds are available. St. Augustine & Holy Family statues are now in place at the Santuario. SCAN TO DONATE

**Theme: Joyful in Hope.**  
The Bible readings for today tell us again about a bright future, seemingly a utopia. "Joyful in hope" is a Christian's theme of life. Christian hope opposes despair, which often results in suicide or just "copping out." It opposes escaping from reality through the use of drugs, abuse of alcohol, or excessive addiction to the pleasures of modern life. Christian hope knows how to handle depression: You get on your knees, knowing that "over the world of the stars, a loving Father must reside" ("Ode to Joy" in 9th Symphony of Beethoven). What would you tell a friend who knows that he is a terminal cancer patient? A person without faith or hope might say: "Face it! We all have to die sooner or later!" What would you say? A Christian knows about "More to come. Stay tuned in!"

**FIRST READING Is 35:1-6, 10**  
**[Here Is Your God]**  
This beautiful poem is attributed to the so-called "Second Isaiah," a prophet who stayed with the Hebrews in Babylonian exile. This prophet saw the Babylonian rule about to be

toppled by the mighty King Cyrus of Persia, who would free the captives and let them go home. This is a poem of joyful hope. "Say to those whose hearts are frightened: Be strong, fear not! Here is your God, he comes with vindication." Christians apply this vision to the future brought about by Jesus, the Messiah, God's Anointed One. "Then will the eyes of the blind be opened." The Lord gives sight to the blind. This is our Christian theme of joyful hope: Our Lord, who comes to be a light to the world. The lights of Christmas symbolize this idea.

**SECOND READING Jas 5:7-10**  
**[The Lord's Coming Is at Hand]**  
James reminds us not to be overly optimistic. The bright future of the Messianic era will not be fully realized on this side of the grave. We must be patient! "Make your hearts firm, because the coming of the Lord is at hand." The prophets should be our models. If you are suffering, this reading could be an inspiring starting point for a personal prayer to God!

In the USA the Church celebrates the **Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe**, elsewhere it is an Optional Memorial. Our Lady appeared to an Indian convert named Juan Diego on December 9, 1531. She left a marvelous portrait of herself on the mantle of Juan Diego. This miraculous image has proved to be ageless and is kept in the shrine built in her honor, the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe. In 1910, Our Lady of Guadalupe was declared Patroness of Latin America, and in 1945 Pope Pius XII declared Her to be the Empress of all the Americas.
