Recycling FAQ's (frequently asked questions)

Can I recycle?

- Plastic grocery bags – Not in your curbside BUT they are collected and recycled by participating grocery and retail stores – better yet BYOB (bring your own bag)
- Pizza boxes? – yes but only the portion without food residue or grease.
- Window glass, ceramics or porcelain? Not in your curbside but check Green Guide listings for locations
- Recyclables with food residue? No – food residue will contaminate the recycling process. Take a minute and rinse it.

What about Styrofoam?

From your take-out box to your bike helmet, it can seem like Styrofoam is taking over the world.

Identified easily by recycling number six, Styrofoam is the trademarked name of Expanded Polystyrene (EPS). Commonly used in food and shipping packaging, EPS is cheap to produce, lightweight, and is impossible to degrade naturally over time, making it a big problem for landfills.

McHenry County and the surrounding area have several locations that will take Styrofoam to be recycled. All colors and sizes will be accepted just please make sure it is clean. Please and bring to one of these places:

Platinum Sponsor Highlight: Elgin Recycling Statewide Crisis Limits Local Television Recycling Options



In 2012 the Electronic Products Recycling and Reuse Act banned electronic items from landfills in Illinois. The law required electronics manufacturers to recycle 50 percent of the weight of their products sold in Illinois. However, because new electronics tend to weigh a lot less, these goals are being met much more quickly during the year. Unfortunately, once manufacturers meet their annual goals, they no longer have to pay recycling companies to process consumer

electronics. This situation is complicated by the high cost to process hazardous CRT glass found in televisions and computer monitors. As a result, recyclers are forced to either charge their customers, many of whom are local governments, eliminate drop-offs or are simply forced out of business.

Elgin Recycling, with five full-service facilities including Crystal Lake, Elgin, Elk Grove Township, Gilberts and Palatine, is a local recycler that had to change

their approach to consumer electronics recycling. Elgin Recycling, following strict R2 (Responsible Recycling) standards, is committed to the proper recycling of all electronics. Along with proper recycling and increased CRT processing costs, Elgin Recycling will no longer accept CRT units at their drop-off locations and now has to charge municipalities to hold electronics recycling events. Prior to last summer, Elgin Recycling was typically able to cover the cost of these events, and in some cases offer a small rebate to municipalities, based on the mix of materials that they were taking in. However, now with CRT containing devices comprising as much as 80% of consumer electronics material, the original approach was no longer sustainable.

A solution to this problem would be to amend the state law by increasing the manufacturer goal from 50% of weight sold to at least 80% or more. At press time, State legislators were considering HB1455. ¿Puedo reciclar?

- Bolsas de plástico - No en su borde de acera pero son recolectados y reciclados por supermercados y bodegas que participan - o mejor aún (puede traer su propia bolsa)
- ¿Cajas de pizza? - Si, pero solo la parte sin residuos de alimentos
- ¿Ventanas de vidrio, cerámica, o porcelana? - No en el borde de la acera pero consulte la Guía Ecológica para conocer de lugares en donde puede reciclarlos
- ¿Reciclables con residuos de comida? - No, los residuos de comida pueden contaminar el proceso de reciclaje. Tome un minuto y enjuáguelo.

¿Qué Puedo Hacer con Espuma de Poliestireno (Styrofoam)?

De la caja a su casco de bicicleta, puede parecer que la espuma de poliestireno está apoderándose del mundo. Identificado fácilmente por el número de reciclaje seis, la espuma de poliestireno es el nombre de la marca registrada de Poliestireno Expandido (EPS). De uso general en alimentos y empaques de envío, EPS es de bajo costo, de peso ligero, y es imposible de degradar naturalmente con el tiempo, por lo que es un gran problema para los basureros.

El Condado de McHenry y sus alrededores tienen varias ubicaciones que aceptaran espuma de poliestireno para ser reciclada. Todos los colores y tamaños serán aceptados pero por favor asegúrese de que esté limpio. Por favor guarde su espuma de poliestireno y tráigala a uno de estos lugares:

Yard waste or landscape waste includes grass or shrubbery cuttings, leaves, tree limbs and other materials from the care of lawns, trees, vines and shrubbery. Yard waste is banned from Illinois landfills (Christmas trees are excluded) and open burning is limited in McHenry County.

Most municipalities have a system for collecting landscape waste. Call for more information.

McHenry County Open Burning of Landscape Waste Regulations:

The Open Burning of Landscape Waste Ordinance became effective April 1, 2008 and applies to all areas of McHenry County. If you live in a city with more stringent restrictions, the more restrictive rules apply.

Reducing Your Yard Waste

The best strategy for managing yard waste and your disposal costs is to:

- leave grass clippings on your lawn - you will also reduce your need to weed and fertilize.
- purchase a mulch mower
- shred your leaves
- compost in your backyard
- use grass as ground cover or in flower beds

Reducing the amount of grass you grow and replacing it with ground covers or native wildflower beds invites birds and butterflies to your yard. Birds will serve as nature's insecticide.

Recyclable: includes the reuse, reconditioning and remanufacturing of products or parts in another product. Note: these products may not have recycled content. Check the label.

Recycled content: includes products and packages that contain reused, reconditioned or remanufactured materials, as well as recycled raw materials.
