Misleading Finals

Iowa (-2) beat Rutgers 38-28. However, Rutgers had a 400-346 yard edge. Iowa got an opening kickoff return for a TD and Rutgers missed two field goals.

BYU (-6.5) beat East Carolina 34-13. However, BYU only had a 418-404 yard edge. The Cougars got a "Pick 6" while ECU was also intercepted at the BYU 6-yard line and stopped on downs at the BYU-15.

Duke (-3) beat NC State 45-33. However, NC State had a 535-418 yard edge. NC State led 20-7 at one point and were -4 in turnovers.

Coastal Carolina (+14.5) upset South Alabama 38-20. Coastal was the right side but South Alabama did have a 420-294 yard edge but were -3 in turnovers which included a fumble return TD.

Louisiana Tech (-3) beat Southern Miss 30-20. However, Southern Miss had a 514-340 yard edge.

Bad Beats

Oklahoma (-6.5) beat Auburn 24-17. Auburn had several calls go against them in this game but still led 17-16 late in the fourth quarter. The Sooners scored a TD but missed the 2-point conversion and led 22-17. However, Auburn took several sacks on the last drive, the final one being a safety in the final minute.

Miami, OH (+1.5) lost to UNLV 41-38. The Redhawks opened the week +3.5. Miami led outright all game and still led by 14 entering the fourth quarter. With the game tied at 38-38, Miami was driving for the outright win but fumbled the ball at the UNLV 17-yard line with 2:32 left. UNLV drove down and kick a FG.

Temple (+24.5) covered in a 45-24 loss to Georgia Tech. The Owls got a TD with just :03 left for the backdoor, one play after a pass interference in the end zone.

UAB (+39) covered in a 56-24 loss to Tennessee. The Blazers went 82 yards in 14 plays getting a TD in the final minute for the backdoor.

Western Kentucky (-7.5) beat Nevada 31-16. The line was as high as 11 during the week. Nevada led 13-10 in the fourth quarter. Nevada kicked a FG to make it 24-16 with under :30 left but WKU returned the onside kick for a TD.

The total in the Ball State/Connecticut game was 52.5. It was 24-10 Connecticut with under 4 minutes left. However, the two teams combined for 3 TD's with the last one coming with just :09 left on a rugby style push.

-UCF OL coach Shawn Clark has passed away.

-Buffalo QB Ta'Quan Roberson (foot) is doubtful to play this week vs Connecticut.

-West Virginia QB Nicco Marchiol (foot) is questionable this week. WVU is also dealing with cluster injuries to the RB, WR and OL positions.

-Boise State QB Maddux Madsen is banged up but is expected to play this week.

-Kentucky QB Zach Calzada (shoulder) is unlikely to play this week.

-Iowa RB Jaziun Patterson (ankle) has been ruled out vs Indiana this week.

Games in Rotation Order
Thursday, September 25th

EAST CAROLINA 29 Army 25. Army has played three "to the wire" games so far and are 1-2 with a pair of OT home losses. They are traveling on a short week to an ECU team that was over-powered by BYU at home last week. The early money is on ECU here but we think the value has been priced out.

Friday, September 26th

Florida State 34 VIRGINIA 28. This game is a lot better than what we anticipated coming into the season. The two teams are a combined 6-1. Florida State ranks No. 1 in the country in yards per play margin led by their No.1 offense averaging 629 ypg. UVA has been no slouch with the No. 5 offense averaging 565 ypg. We got a battle here in the market with sharp groups laying 6.5 with FSU and others taking 7 and higher with UVA. We actually prefer the UVA side with FSU having Miami on deck. We also like OVER.

ARIZONA STATE 30 TCU 27. Really good game here in the Big 12. TCU is 3-0 coming off a win over rival SMU while Arizona State got a last-second FG win over Baylor. TCU has the better ypp margin but Arizona State has played the tougher schedule. We bet Arizona State.

Houston 30 OREGON STATE 17. One one side, you have a 3-0 SU and 3-0 ATS Houston team fresh off a bye. On the other, you have a Oregon State team that is 0-4 SU and 0-4 ATS failing to cover by an average of 8.6 points per game. The Beavers have played one of the toughest schedules in the country so far. We bet Houston early in the week but the value has been priced out.

Saturday, September 27th

OHIO 31 Bowling Green 20. A big battle in the market here with groups laying -9.5 with Ohio and others taking 10 and 10.5 with BG. Makes sense considering it's around a key number. We're on the Ohio side of things as the Bobcats have played the tougher schedule. They have the best player in the MAC in Parker Navarro and are playing back-to-back at home while the Falcons are on back-to-back road trips.

JAMES MADISON 36 Georgia Southern 22. James Madison is 3-0 ATS and has the No. 6 defense in the country allowing just 215 ypg. Georgia Southern has won and covered their last two games but they rank No. 130 in total defense. With that being said, our ratings are liking the big underdog here.

TOLEDO 34 Akron 16. He did it again! Toledo head coach Jason Candle has now lost a national-high 16 games as a favorite since the start of the 2021 season. 11 of those losses have come as a TD favorite or more. That includes Saturday as Toledo blew a 13-0 lead as a 13.5-point favorite at Western Michigan. VIP clients did get WMU as a play. Now the Rockets face a re-energized Akron offense after crushing Duquesne last week. We bet Akron.

Utah 30 WEST VIRGINIA 17. You need to be following the injury report here. First, Utah QB Dampier is not 100% healthy and word is, he is not practicing so far this week. However, WVU QB Marchiol is questionable at best here and the Mountaineers are dealing with cluster injuries at RB, WR and OL. Both teams were blown out last week. We bet Utah early in the week but are worried about Dampier.

OLD DOMINION 32 Liberty 18. Old Dominion is 3-0 ATS and coming off a bye. Their offense ranks No. 4 in the country averaging 8.1 yards per play and they have a weapon in the QB run game. Meanwhile, Liberty is a pathetic 0-4 ATS failing to cover by 11.8 points per game. We bet ODU -9.5 early in the week but numbers matter and we now are showing value on the big underdog.

Memphis 36 FLORIDA ATLANTIC 24. We really like the spot here for FAU coming off a bye. They have been a little bit better than the final scoreboards have indicated as the Owls are -8 in turnovers. They run the fastest tempo in the country and are catching Memphis off a big upset win over Arkansas. The Tigers trailed 28-10 and benefitted from an Arkansas fumble late. We bet FAU and we think the dog is live here.

San Diego State 23 NORTHERN ILLINOIS 21. The San Diego State/Cal last week might have had the most shocking final of the season so far. San Diego State, a 2-TD underdog won 34-0. Now they travel across the country to take on a NIU team that has a pair of losses to Maryland and Mississippi State who are a surprising 8-0. We like the dog here but were hoping for a "+3" or better.

Notre Dame 35 ARKANSAS 31. Both teams desperately need a win. The Irish are 1-2 and a loss will officially knock them out of the play-offs. ND's defense ranks No. 118 allowing 32.7 ppg. Now they face an Arkansas offense that ranks No. 5 in ypp at 8.1 and No. 8 averaging 552 ypg. The Hogs could easily be 4-0 but have fumbled each of the last two week's on potential game-winning drives. Arkansas HC Pittman is dangerous in these types of games.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

BOSTON COLLEGE 29 California 25. Both teams are coming off outright losses as 2-TD favorites. BC did have a bye last week and are catching Cal on a long trip with a true freshman QB that showed some inconsistency last week. We thought we would be on BC here as one of our favorite plays of the week but the number is way too expensive. **Connecticut 27 BUFFALO 23.** Both teams have been disappointing so far. Buffalo blew a big 4Q lead last week at home to Troy. They also lost their starting QB to injury. UConn has the better ypp margin and has played the tougher schedule. We bet UConn early in the week but the market has adjusted accordingly.

NC STATE 32 Virginia Tech 23. Virginia Tech got their first win of the season last week albeit against an FCS school. The Hokies are still 0-4 ATS failing to cover by 15.1 points per game. They had several starters sit out last week as they continue to contemplate their futures with VT having an interim coach. NC State is off their first loss of the season at Duke. It was misleading as NC State had a 535-418 yard edge but were -4 in turnovers. We haven't bet side or total.

Indiana 28 IOWA 22. Indiana is coming off one of the most impressive performances of the entire CFB season so far as they hammered Illinois 63-10. The Hoosiers now rank No. 1 in the country in yards per game margin at an incredible +383. They've also moved up to No. 8 in our power ratings. Now they have a tricky road game here vs an Iowa team that had their best performance of the season last week in a win at Rutgers. Spot says Iowa but we actually prefer OVER.

Louisville 31 PITTSBURGH 27. Pitt comes in off the bye after blowing a 10-point 4Q lead to West Virginia. The Panthers still rank No. 21 in yards per play margin. Louisville ranks No. 16 in that category (+2.8) but neither team has played that difficult of a schedule so far. We bet Pitt on the openers but would pass at current.

Duke 30 SYRACUSE 27. The main storyline here is that Syracuse QB Steve Angeli is out for the season with an Achilles and Rickie Collins will be making his first start. The Orange come in feeling good about themselves after pulling the upset at Clemson. Meanwhile, Duke comes in off a much-needed win vs NC State. We downgraded Syracuse even after the big win but it seems like the market values Angeli more than we do.

Georgia Tech 34 WAKE FOREST 19. Georgia Tech backers were dealt a tough blow last week when Temple scored a TD with :03 left to get the backdoor cover. The Yellow Jackets offense continues to hum along averaging 8.1 yards per play (No. 6). Wake comes in off the bye and the market says they are the sharper side so far. Our ratings like GT (see page 6).

CENTRAL MICHIGAN 30 Eastern Michigan 24. The first match-up between the Michigan directional schools this year sees both teams coming off a win. Central has been better in the stats at -1.2 ypp (vs -1.5) so far while having played a tougher schedule than EMU. That makes this 6-point spread seem fair.

NORTHWESTERN 25 UCLA 21. Both teams come in off a bye. UCLA fired their head coach after a disastrous 0-3 start highlighted by a 35-10 loss at home to New Mexico, one of the worst performances in the history of the program. We've downgraded UCLA more than any team in the country but it appears the market has downgraded them even more. We think interim coach Tim Skipper will be an upgrade over DeShaun Foster. Lean Bruins.

MINNESOTA 27 Rutgers 23. Both teams are coming off a loss and with tough schedules ahead need this one to ensure bowl eligibility. Minnesota is off a bye after losing at Cal. We thought Rutgers played better than the final score indicated vs Iowa last week (see misleading finals on page 1). We bet Rutgers at +5.5. We like their passing game.

VANDERBILT 41 Utah State 18. Both teams are 4-0 ATS. Vanderbilt is No. 1 in the country with a +19.5 points per game cover margin this year (minimum 4 games). Utah State is No. 3 covering their games by an average of 14.8 points per game. Vanderbilt easily covered vs Georgia State last week as a big favorite but do have Alabama on deck.

AIR FORCE 31 Hawaii 25. A lot of early week money has come in on Air Force here. It makes sense. The Falcons are backed up against the wall at 1-2. Their defense has been abysmal ranking dead last allowing 7.6 yards per play. They are playing a Hawaii team already playing a 6th straight week and they're not the same team off the islands. Spot says Air Force, ratings say Hawaii. We lean OVER.

BOISE STATE 37 Appalachian State 21. Appalachian State comes in off a bye and the box scores are better than the final scores in each of their last two games. Boise is off Air Force and has a huge game at Notre Dame on deck. Their QB Madsen is banged up but will play here. We gave out Appalachian State on our Covers Monday show (8-2 the last two weeks).

NEW MEXICO 32 New Mexico State 20. The Rio Grande Rivalry has been very competitive as of late with New Mexico holding a 8-7 lead in the last 15 meetings. Both teams come in off a bye. The Lobos are coming off one of their best wins in school history as they crushed UCLA 35-10 as 2-TD underdogs. New head coach Jason Eck has continued the momentum that Bronco Mendenhall started last year. Early week money is on NM but we can't get this high in our power ratings. **STANFORD 26 San Jose State 23.** San Jose State beat Stanford last year 34-31 in the regular season finale. Both teams have had uneven performances this season. San Jose St almost lost to Idaho last week as a big favorite and did lose to Central Michigan already in that role. Stanford followed up their big upset win over Boston College with a blowout loss. We lean Stanford.

SOUTHERN MISS 28 Jacksonville State 25. The betting markets love this Southern Miss team. They are 2-2 but continue to get "bet on" each week. Jacksonville State has been better than expected at 2-2 SU. They rank No. 8 in the country in rushing offense and we tend to gravitate towards running dogs.

KANSAS 30 Cincinnati 23. Cincinnati comes in off a bye. The Bearcats rank No. 3 in the country in yards per play margin. Kansas has played the much tougher schedule and are off a blowout win over West Virginia. We think Kansas is the better team, has the much better coach and has an underrated new home venue.

IOWA STATE 28 Arizona 19. Both teams are coming off a bye. Both have beat Kansas State already this season Arizona outgaining Kansas State by 219 yards and Iowa State getting outgained by 70. Arizona's defense under new DC Danny Gonzales has been much improved as they rank No. 4 allowing just 3.6 yards per play. Iowa State has played the much more difficult schedule and this is the first road game of the season for Arizona.

NAVY 30 Rice 15. Rice is off to a 3-1 start. The Owls are running the option this year and the market is treating this more like a Commander-In-Chief game. Navy's offense is averaging 44 points per game. The Middies are 3-0 and are coming off a bye. Pass.

Tennessee 37 MISSISSIPPI STATE 27. Two teams that play with a ton of tempo as Tennessee ranks No. 2 in the country in plays per minute while Mississippi State ranks No. 9. The Bulldogs are 4-0 straight up and 4-0 ATS covering their games by an average of 9.4 points per game. Yes, they pulled an upset over Arizona State at home but this Tennessee team is much better. We like the Vols.

Baylor 38 OKLAHOMA STATE 18. Oklahoma State has fired Mike Gundy after 21 seasons and 170 wins. The Cowboys have fallen on hard times having lost 11 straight games to FBS opponents and were embarrassed at home by Tulsa last week. Crazy to think they were playing in the Big 12 Championship game two years ago and now are the worst power conference team in the country. Baylor is 2-2 and needs a feel-good win.

SOUTH CAROLINA 27 Kentucky 21. One of the bigger games of the weekend as far as the future of both programs. Tough seeing either team make a bowl game without a win here. Yes, that's right...South Carolina who was ranked in the Top 10 just two weeks will struggle to make a bowl game. Kentucky is the much better running team (No. 28 vs No. 130) but our ratings lean SC here.

NORTH TEXAS 36 South Alabama 24. North Texas is riding high at 4-0. However, they have two wins in OT and easily could be 2-2. They're taking on a wounded South Alabama team that lost outright by 18 as 14.5-point favorites last week. We laid 10 with North Texas early in the week knowing the market would like them here but we don't see value at the current price.

KANSAS STATE 27 Ucf 23. The market really likes Kansas State here. Yes, the Wildcats are coming off a bye and yes we think UCF is overrated due to a very weak schedule so far. However, we can't trust a Kansas State team that hasn't come anywhere close to expectations this year. They are 0-4 ATS failing to cover by 14.5 points per game.

Lsu 27 OLE MISS 26. Alabama at Georgia and Oregon at Penn State are getting all the hype this week. However, we think this game is just as big for a pair of 4-0 teams looking to make the playoffs. We can't wait to watch Ole Miss No. 9 offense averaging 543 ypg vs LSU's defense allowing just 9.3 ppg (No. 9). Chambliss has given the Ole Miss offense more punch the last couple of weeks but we lean LSU here.

Tulane 34 TULSA 19. Tulane comes in off the blowout loss to Ole Miss. The Green Wave's playoff goals are still intact and it starts here in conference play. Tulsa is coming off one of their biggest wins in recent memory as they beat Oklahoma State. Tulane has played the much tougher schedule and we like them to get a bounce back win. We bet them at -13.5 but would pass at current.

UL-LAFAYETTE 25 Marshall 23. Tough seeing either team make a bowl game without a win here. Marshall does come in off back-to-back wins. However, ULL has the better ypp margin. Could be a sneaky OVER with both teams coming off their best offensive performances. **Use 34 ILLINOIS 29.** Illinois lost 63-10 to Indiana last week. Now they welcome in the No. 1 offense in the country in yards per play as the Trojans average an incredibly 9.3. This should be easy...right? We're not so sure as we haven't liked what we've seen from USC's defense the last couple of weeks and they are 0-4 ATS the last two years traveling east in conference play. Illinois' backs are against the walls. We lean Illinois.

UL-MONROE 27 Arkansas State 25. ULM comes in off an upset win at UTEP last week where they led 31-7 at one point and had a 250-33 rushing yard edge. They are taking on a desperate Arkansas State team who is 1-3 and got upset by Kennesaw State last week. We lean UNDER.

MISSOURI 51 Massachusetts 7. We lean OVER. The two teams are a combined 7-0 to the OVER this year with Missouri games going OVER by an average of 12.6 points per game. Missouri is 4-0 and playing their 5th straight home game. UMass is 0-3 SU and 0-3 ATS and are coming off a bye.

TEXAS A&M 30 Auburn 23. Texas A&M is coming off a bye after their big dramatic upset win over Notre Dame in the final seconds. Is this the year they finally turn the corner? Auburn had a chance for a statement win last week but fell short in Norman. Several calls went against them and their backers suffered a bad beat with a safety late. This is their 3rd tough road game already and QB Jackson Arnold holds onto the ball too long vs a Mike Elko defense.

KENNESAW STATE 28 Middle Tennessee 23. The market is really trusting Kennesaw State here with a 7.5-point spread. The Owls have been better than expected winning their last two games. Meanwhile, 2nd-year Middle Tennessee coach Derek Mason can ill afford another loss after already losing to Austin Peay and Marshall. We lean with the dog especially above the key 7.

Western Kentucky 31 MISSOURI STATE 27. We like what we have seen from this Missouri State team. After being overwheled at USC, they have covered 3 straight games. Speaking of covering, WKU got a miracle cover vs Nevada last week. They trailed 13-10 in the fourth quarter and were as high as 11-point favorites during the week. After a Nevada field goal cut it to 24-16, WKU returned the onside kick for a TD in the final seconds. We bet Missouri State.

COLORADO STATE 29 Washington State 23. Colorado State will be starting a new QB here as Jackson Brousseau has been named the starter this week. Brayden Fowler-Nicolosi has been benched. This coming on the heels of the offense averaging just 19.3 points per game so far. Washington State has already been shuffling QB's this year. Their 59-24 loss to Washington was a little closer than the final as Wazzu trailed 31-24 entering the fourth quarter. Our ratings like CSU.

PENN STATE 28 Oregon 26. One of the biggest games of the CFB season so far. We know both teams are good but how good? Neither has played that difficult of a schedule. Especially Penn State who has been at least a 6-TD favorite in every game. The Nittany Lions are off a bye but are 0-3 ATS. Oregon has played the tougher schedule of the two and the Ducks have the better yards per play margin (+4.0 vs +2.8). Do you trust Oregon QB Dante Moore in a "White Out? If so, Oregon is clearly the play.

GEORGIA 28 Alabama 24. Georgia is 1-9 the last 10 meetings vs Alabama. Kirby Smart is 1-6 and lost to Kalen DeBoer last year. UGA needs this badly (so does DeBoer). Both teams come in off a bye. Georgia has by far the best win of the two by beating Tennessee on the road but Alabama is much better in the stats (+2.6 ypp vs +0.7). The market does not like Georgia this year but we like them here.

Louisiana Tech 25 UTEP 22. The market loved UTEP at home last week only to see them lose outright to ULM. Louisiana Tech is 4-0 ATS with an average cover of 15.4 points per game. We think it's been "fool's gold" as they are -32.5 ypg.

Ohio State 31 WASHINGTON 21. The No. 1 Buckeyes have been out of the national spotlight the last few weeks and are coming off a bye. They're taking on a Washington team that has won 22 straight road games. Washington ranks in the Top in ypp, ypg and ppg margins but are taking a huge step up in class. Early week market likes them but we're getting close to firing on Ohio State.

Byu 26 COLORADO 21. BYU crushed Colorado in the bowl game last year. The Cougars are 3-0 SU and ATS but the Buffs will be their toughest test. If Colorado has finally settled down on a QB, we think they are the side here.

Games in Rotation Order

Thursday, September 25th

Seattle 22 ARIZONA 21. Both teams come in at 2-1 with both teams' losses coming at the hands of San Francisco is low scoring games. Seattle has been the much more impressive team in the box score with a +0.9 yards per play margin while Arizona is -0.1. Both have played similar strength of schedules. There was a respected group that came in on Seattle earlier this week but another we respect came in on Arizona on Wednesday. We don't expect to be involved unless it's the Cardinals on a teaser.

Sunday, September 28th

† **Minnesota 23 Pittsburgh 19.** @Croke Park in Dublin, Ireland. Both teams are 2-1. We think Minnesota is significantly better. The Vikings are +0.7 in yards per play margin while the Steelers are -1.3 ranking No. 29 in the league. The Steelers had an extremely misleading win at New England last week where they got out-gained 369-203 and were -1.1 in ypp but were +4 in turnovers. New England had 2 turnovers at the goal line. The favorite in the NFL overseas games is 32-18 ATS. We expect it to go to 33-18.

Philadelphia 24 TAMPA BAY 21. Both teams are 3-0 but both are very fortunate to be 3-0 as all 3 wins by both teams have come by one possession. Last week Philly trailed the Rams 26-7 but made their biggest home comeback since 1988. The Eagles blocked a FG on the final play and returned it for a TD giving Rams backers one of the worst NFL beats in recent memory (Rams were our only VIP loser of the entire CFB/NFL weekend). Meanwhile, Tampa became the first team in the Super Bowl era to win their first 3 games all in the final minute. Tampa is the better team in the stats (0.0 ypp vs Philly's -0.9). Tough going against Philly and their 19-1 SU current run but we'll take the home dog with "the hook".

BUFFALO 31 New Orleans 16. By far the biggest point spread of the young NFL season so far. Since 2003, 3-0 SU teams are 14-4 ATS vs 0-3 SU teams. The Bills haven't been dominant as they rank No. 11 in ypp margin. They were tied at 21-21 with Miami last Thursday. The Saints were blown out at Seattle trailing 38-6 at halftime. We're typically dog or pass on these big point spreads but don't expect to be heavily involved.

NEW ENGLAND 24 Carolina 17. A classic "inside out" handicap here. The Patriots had a very misleading loss to the Steelers last week. New England had a 369-203 yard edge but were done in by 5 turnovers (most for them since 2008) including a pair at the 2-yard line going in for scores. Meanwhile, Carolina got a 30-0 win over Atlanta but somehow got out-gained by more than 100 yards. The Falcons had 3 turnovers and missed a pair of field goals. Tough laying points with losing teams but we think New England is the right side here.

ATLANTA 24 Washington 22. Marcus Mariota got his first start since 2022 and the Commanders were able to get a win without Jayden Daniels last week. They're playing an Atlanta team off an embarrassing 30-0 loss to Carolina last week. It was a very misleading final as the Falcons had a 332-224 yard edge but had 3 turnovers and missed 2 FG's. Statistically Atlanta has the better yards per play margin (+0.8 vs +0.5) and have played the tougher schedule. Jayden Daniels remains day-to-day (aren't we all?) and we like the Falcons to get the win.

Detroit 25 CLEVELAND 17. We gave out Cleveland to VIP clients last week and with five minutes left, we looked like idiots with Green Bay leading 10-0. However, Cleveland got the miraculous outright win 13-10 thanks to a 55-yard FG on the final play. They're catching a Detroit team off one of the more impressive wins of the entire NFL season beating Baltimore on the road on MNF. Detroit destroyed Chicago at home a few weeks ago but we think Cleveland will give them a better test. The Browns are +0.6 in ypp margin despite playing one of the toughest schedules so far. Meanwhile Detroit is +0.7 also playing one of the toughest schedules.

HOUSTON 24 Tennessee 16. When you have a matchup of winless teams, the underdog is 76-44-5 ATS. However, there are exceptions to the rule and we might have that here. First, Tennessee is by far the worst team in the NFL at -2.5 in ypp margin. The Titans are on an historically bad ATS run at 3-17 since the start of last season. Meanwhile the Texans are much better than their 0-3 record with 3 close losses and a +0.1 ypp margin.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

L.A. Chargers 24 N.Y. GIANTS 19. Since 2003, 3-0 SU teams are 14-4 ATS vs 0-3 SU teams. Jaxson Dart will get the start here for the Giants as Russell Wilson has been benched. The Chargers come off 3 straight wins all vs division opponents. Not sure this is a great spot traveling east on a 10am PT start. The Giants have been bad but are just -0.3 in ypp margin (No. 20). We actually lean with the home dog here.

SAN FRANCISCO 26 Jacksonville 22. Solid AFC vs NFC matchup here. The 49ers are 3-0 despite dealing with numerous injuries. The latest being Nick Bosa out for the season with an ACL injury. San Francisco should be used to injuries at this point as it seems to be a major issue throughout the Shanahan era. Still, they are 3-0 and are +1.0 in ypp margin and Mac Jones has been solid at QB filling in for Brock Purdy. The Jags are 2-1 and are +0.7 in ypp margin. However, we're not buying them as legit contenders yet. A group we respect bet OVER early in the week and we agree.

L.A. RAMS 27 Indianapolis 22. The Colts come in a 3-0 and are tied atop the NFL with a +1.6 yards per play margin. However, the Colts have played arguably the weakest schedule so far in the NFL. The Rams are also +1.6 in yards per play margin and have played a tougher slate of opponents. Their backers suffered one of the toughest beats in recent history as they blew a 26-7 lead vs the Eagles last week getting a potential game-winning FG blocked and returned for a TD on the final play. We like the Rams here and are hoping some more "-3's" appear in the market.

LAS VEGAS 24 Chicago 22. The Bears picked up their first win of the season last week as they benefited from a +4 turnover margin vs the Cowboys. They're taking on a Las Vegas team that lost by 17 at Washington who was starting Marcus Mariota at QB. You have a pair of 1st-year coaches but we trust the Las Vegas staff a little more here. The Raiders are slightly better in the stats and have played a tougher schedule.

Baltimore 25 KANSAS CITY 23. Hard to imagine that the loser of this game will fall to 1-3. Both have been disappointments this season. Both you could argue are a little bit better than their record as Baltimore is +0.5 in ypp margin while KC is +0.3. The Ravens are traveling on a short week after losing a shootout on MNF to the Lions. The Chiefs did pick up their first win of the season but it came against the lowly Giants. The Chiefs offense has not looked the part but neither has the Baltimore defense. Patrick Mahomes was on a 11-2 SU and 11-1-1 ATS run as an underdog from 2017-2023 but has lost two of his last three. Make it 3 of his last 4.

Green Bay 28 DALLAS 21. Both teams come in off disappointing losses. The Packers led the lowly Browns 10-0 with 5 minutes left in the fourth quarter but somehow lost 13-10 getting upset as 7.5-point road favorites. Meanwhile the Cowboys fell to the Bears 31-14 as 1-point road favorites. The game was closer than the final as the Cowboys were -4 in turnovers. Obviously, we trust the Green Bay organization over the Cowboys to get a bounce back performance. It will be interesting to see what kind of reaction Micah Parsons gets from the Dallas faithful. We prefer OVER here.

Monday, September 29th

MIAMI 24 N.Y. Jets 21. A pair of 0-3 teams. Both have played tough schedules. Both teams are -0.7 in yards per play margin. The Jets are making their second straight trip to Florida after losing a heart-breaker to the Bucs. Meanwhile, the Dolphins have extra time to prep after losing to the Bills on Thursday night. We don't like either team. We don't like either coach. We don't expect to be involved on the side. Lean OVER.

DENVER 25 Cincinnati 18. The Bengals come in off the embarrassing 48-10 loss to the Vikings where they were -5 in turnovers. Still, Cincy is 2-1 while the Broncos are sitting at 1-2 off back-to-back losses at the gun. Denver is the better team in the stats with a +0.3 ypp margin while Cincy is -1.4 (No. 30). While we are not wild about laying the 7.5, we think Denver is a great 2nd leg to any teaser you may have this weekend.
