





BIGFOOT BRAWL ENDURO RACE RULES

GENERAL RULES:

- 1. All drivers must be 16 years of age or older. All drivers under the age of 18 must have a minor's release of liability form signed by a parent or guardian and on file with Trinity County Fair Association.
- 2. A mandatory meeting for all drivers will be held in the pits by the white board before the race.
- 3. Each car will be inspected for basic safety requirements.
- 4. Starting positions for both Sessions will be drawn.
- 5. Drivers will hold their positions until given the green flag after a crowd countdown.
- 6. The Yellow flag will not be used. If there are cars with breakdowns or in accidents, the other cars will avoid them while continuing the race.
- 7. The Red flag will only be used if there is a fire, rollover, debris, or the track is blocked. All cars must stop and THERE WILL BE NO TRACK ASSISTANCE UNLESS THERE IS FIRE OR ROLLOVER.
- 8. Unless a hazard exists, the driver may not get out of his/her car on the racing surface or service his/her car in the infield with green flag and during racing conditions.
- 9. In the event your car becomes inoperable, try to get off the track. If you stall, you will be removed as soon as possible.
- 10.NO DRIVERS' DOOR (or Passenger if present) HITS ALLOWED. A car intentionally hitting a driver (or passenger) door will be disqualified at the discretion of the track official.
- 11. This is a Winner Takes All format. The First Place Winner only will be paid.
- 12.If your car doesn't move for a minimum of 4 minutes, then you are out.
- 13. Drivers must stay in their vehicle at all times during green flag racing.
- 14. Cars cannot leave the designated Enduro Track for repairs during green flag racing or you are out.







CAR AND BODY RULES:

- 1. Car number plate must be welded to the top of the car, derby style, so it remains visible.
- 2. Safety nets must be over the driver's door (also passenger door, if passenger is present).
- 3. Seatbelts or 5-point harness is recommended.
- 4. All glass must be removed from the vehicle. Screen is mandatory to keep debris from flying in the driver's face.
- 5. Bumpers can be reinforced to avoid falling off on the track.
- 6. NO 4-WD vehicles. All wheel drive vehicles must have the sensor disabled or car will be disqualified.
- 7. Trucks and SUV's can be no higher than 28" to the top of the bumper. No Duellies or Flatbed vehicles, Derby cars are allowed.
- 8. Windshield must have bracing in two locations.
- 9. Doors must have a plate or bar welded to provide safety or basic 4-point cage.

SAFETY:

- 1. Drivers and passengers MUST wear a helmet. Fire suits are highly recommended.
- 2. Seatbelts and/or 5-point harness is recommended.
- 3. Car must be equipped with 'halo' and plated doors.
- 4. Extra bracing is allowed as a safety feature.

OVERVIEW:

30-minute intermission, this is the time that participants can do repairs on vehicles. This is not a demolition derby, more like paint to pass, rubbing, spinning each other out and pushing people is allowed. No kill shots, if driving too aggressive you will get back flagged and kicked off the track, at the discretion of the track official. Beauty Contest will take place before event starts and winner will receive a trophy.
