
Last week we continued the discussion of the seven(7) Redemptive/Motivational Gifts. God distributes The Redemptive/Motivational Gifts throughout the Body of Christ, namely: the gifts of the: Prophet, Server, Teacher, Exhorter, Giver, Leader, or the Showing of Mercy. These Gifts of God's Grace shape how the believer views life, relates to others, and impacts the Body of Christ. A Redemptive/Motivational gift can be compared to a set of eyeglasses from God, given so that the believer can see people and circumstances through that particular set of "lenses." Regardless of our gift(s), God inspired the Apostle Paul to write that, in essence, we can have ALL these gifts but the greatest gift that each of us to have is "LOVE". The other gifts will find their place because of the love of God. Everything that God does is motivated by love, because God "IS" Love.
