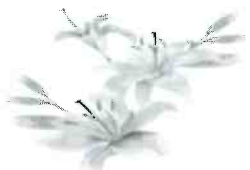

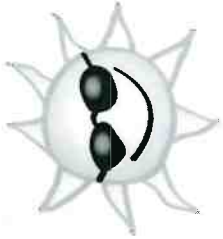
During a recent survey of the community, it was noted that there were many properties needing to have the house and/or driveway cleaned of dirt, mildew/mold and driveways and/or sidewalks with grass/weeds that need attention.

If your property borders the fence in Shadowmoss it is your responsibility to keep the inside of the fence clean. Florida humidity makes it very easy for mold and mildew to flourish—a quick spray of bleach and water usually takes care of problem areas.

If you live on a cul-de-sac please make sure that you are cutting your lawn and other trees/plants all the way to the end of the property which is often times where the mailboxes are located.

Please take a moment to survey your property to see if anything needs attention. Property owners are responsible for maintaining the exterior of their properties per our governing documents.
