CONTEST UPDATES: Refer to the Technical Standards for guidance.

All competitors must create a one-page resume and submit a hard copy to the technical committee chair at orientation. Failure to do so will result in a 10-point penalty.

During the pre-contest orientation session, the contest chair will administer a written test to all team members. All team members, including registered alternates must take the written test to be eligible to participate with their team in the active rounds. Participants are responsible to bring a No. 2 pencil to use for the written test.

There will be 2 rounds. 1st round is elimination round. Only 4 high school teams, and 4 postsecondary teams will advance to round 2 or Final round.

NOTE: All Mobile devices, cell phones, recording devices, and smart watches or other items deemed hazardous to the integrity of the contest are grounds for disqualification.
