Meeting Minutes: The February 2024 meeting minutes were approved.

GTNA Branding: It was agreed that the "muscle arm" logo is the least attractive logo. The logo that is on both neighborhood signs or the image of the old concrete sign (was at Piping Rock and Whitney Way) are the most favored. Ms. Ewanowski stated that she needs the final image as a jpeg file for MailChimp. Ms. Arena will convert the image to a .jpg file and email it to Ms. Ewanowski. The actual files are Vector files which are the preferred format for printing. The group agreed that we need to use the same logo across all social media platforms. The dark green image is attractive and would look good in green if we are doing a one-color printing. Ms. Gale suggested using the concrete sign that was at Piping Rock and Whitney Way. The group felt that a good place to use the picture of the concrete sign is on the website

Gallop T-Shirts: Ms. Powers reported we will have T-shirt funds for the 4th of July event. She reported we have received the following commitments for the Gallop T-shirts: We have received sponsorship contributions from Woodman's, Vitense, Hy-Vee, Seafood Center, and Nonno's, for a total of \$875. Ms. Sheahan will follow up with Meadowood and Orchard Ridge neighborhood associations to determine if they are still interested in combining efforts/advertising. To date, there has been no response. <u>Membership</u>: Ms. Ewanowski reported we received one new membership for a total of 226 members. Ms. Ewanowski would like help distributing new member packets. Ms. Batha offered to deliver packets. They will coordinate this effort.

<u>Treasurer Report</u>: Mr. Ewanowski reported that as of February 29, 2024 the balance of the account was \$3,121.61, February income of \$15, February expenses of \$553.99 for printing directories, and \$99.99 for website service renewal.

Other items:

- Sarah Hyun is the new layout designer of the Stump. Thank you to Marsha Swenson for training Sarah on layout design.
- Ms. Arena asked if we have any leftover t-shirts from past years. We do not have any leftovers.
- Suggestion: Wear your old Gallop shirt to the 4th of July.
- Madison Teacher's Union is hosting a community event regarding staffing shortages in MMSC.
 The event will be held on March 9 (East Side) and March 10 (West Side). Mr. Olson opined
 that he feels that they are a solid organization looking out for the best interests of the children.
 Mr. Russell will poll the board for their opinion about formally endorsing this meeting. This
 could be viewed as a political organization which would be a violation of the Bylaws.
- <u>Volunteer of the Year</u>: Rather than award a Volunteer of the Year, we should acknowledge individual efforts to improve the neighborhood on the Website and in the Stump. An alternate suggestion is to have residents that have lived in Greentree for a long time tell their stories.
- Ms. Ewanowski and Ms. Clark: Mail Chimp free membership allows only 1 owner. A wider subscription will costs \$13/month, \$156/year. This is something the Board will need to consider as an ongoing expense.
