You are invited to become part of the entertainment featured at the Yavapai County Fair, Sept 7-10, 2017. We will feature a wide variety of continuous, free entertainment during the fair. It's a great opportunity to perform in public and gain notoriety for artists of all types.

One-hour time slots are available Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. You may request to perform once or multiple times.

Performers will receive gate admission tickets for your entry into the event. The Yavapai Fair will only be offering gate admission into the fair for the participant & teachers/directors only. The admission pass is non-transferable and may not be used in conjunction with any other event.

Please return the enclosed application as soon as possible. Acts are selected and scheduled by the General Manager with consideration given to the order in which the applications are received. The deadline to submit your application is August 1, 2017. Applications may still be considered after this date. Be sure to complete applications completely including day and evening phone numbers.

We request that you confirm your availability prior to submitting your application. As cancellations impact other performers and their ability to receive a preferred performance time. Please note: All cancellations must be received no later than September 1st, 2017 and must include all admission passes issued to your group. You will be held responsible for the monetary value of your passes based at \$6.00 times the total number of your group if you do not return the pass or cancel by September 1st, 2017.

-Performance Guidelines-

- Each group will be designated a sixty (60) minute time slot on stage. This included set-up, performance, and tear down. *Additional slots may be requested
- You must arrive as a group no less than thirty (30) minutes before your scheduled time and be at your stage area ready to go on stage as scheduled. *Late arrivals may not be allowed to perform.
- The members of your group are responsible for set-up and tear down before and after your performance. Instruction and supervision will be provided by the Stage Manager.
- Each stage is equipped with a sound system.
- The Yavapai Fair will not provide a keyboard or any other specialty equipment.
- NO Vehicles will be allowed to drive onto the grounds. If you have large equipment that needs to be unloaded, please make prior arrangements, by calling the Yavapai Fair office.
- We reserve the right to shut down and cancel any act that does not abide by the guidelines and standards of the Yavapai County Fair.
- The Yavapai County Fair is a family event. Any of the following issues will not be tolerated include but not limited to: Foul language, mistreatment of staff or patrons, abuse of equipment, lack of professionalism, refusal to set-up or tear-down, no show or tardiness, You show will be shut down immediately and you will be removed from the premises and held responsible for any loss or damages.
