On July 14<sup>th</sup>, 2017 a release was made advising of the purchase of tracks by the Lebanon Outing Club and how we were going to move forward. The Lebanon Outing Club at Storrs Hill Ski Area is pleased to announce the installation of the Stainless Steel Tracks on both the K25 and the K50 Ski Jumps has been completed!

Ski jumping played a huge part in the birth of the Lebanon Outing Club, and since its birth, ski jumping at Storrs Hill Ski Area has seen many changes and improvements.

Our ski jumping program has changed quite a bit in the past few years. We have had increased interest from multiple jumping teams and facilities. We now have multiple organizations interested in scheduling training time and events on our K50. We welcome your jumping or racing team to contact us if you are interested in usage.

The stainless steel tracks will play a huge role for not only our jumping program at the Lebanon Outing Club but for other ski jumping programs all over the greater New England area and beyond. There are many benefits to these upgrades, including but not limited to: training for our youth jumpers; the jump will be ready at any given point as there will no longer be a need to make snow on the jump trestle; the in-line for the jumpers to ski in will be a perfect track; will allow the jumpers the ability to focus more on technique and form; the K25 will offer stainless and snow track; and yes finally, this will make the Lebanon Outing Club one step closer to becoming a year round ski jumping facility.

The installation team has put in countless hours. There have been many discussions, meetings, drawings, and volunteer hours to make this all happen. This project creation started in May with the physical process beginning in July. The second phase of this project will begin in the spring of 2018, with the hope of getting a final grade for the landing hills.
