SB190 continues to be a topic of discussion with the Commission tabling the issue until the legislation does some sort of fix to the issue. County Clerk, Melissa Meek advised she has had a few people stop by her office and inquire what the Commission would be doing. She reported that all who have stopped by have been very receptive to what she is telling them about the bill. The patrons were not aware of the problems that are associated with the bill.
