FROM THE PRESIDENT

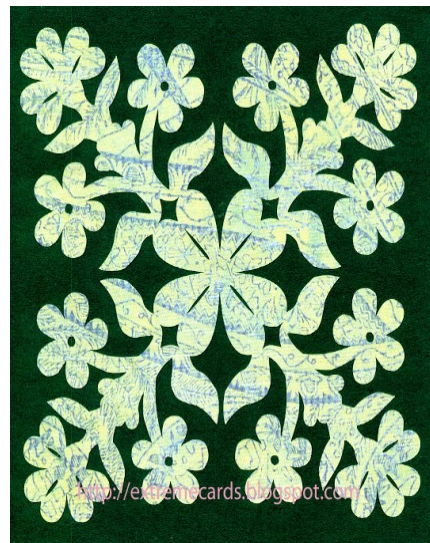
Hello everyone.

STRIPS & SQUARES

All of the fabrics exchanged this year will be BATIKS. No need to wash before cutting and exchanging. Please share your favorite way to use strips and squares with us, and we will bring in some examples from time to time.

The colors below indicate the month you drop off that color. I will get the exchanged sets back to you the following month.

Plan to exchange at least six (6) 2 1/2" width of fabric strips, and sixteen (16) 6" squares. You will get the same number returned as you put in, but be sure to indicate the amount if it is different from the regular exchange. It takes about 1/2 yard of fabric to make either the strips or the squares, or one yard for both. Cut the strips the entire width of the fabric. You can do just strips or squares.

You can give me more than one set of strips or squares or both. If you give me two sets of strips, for example, please use different fabrics for each set. If you will miss a meeting, or it is more convenient, please leave sets for several months and I will exchange them the correct month.

August: Green/Aqua

Sept.: Yellow/Gold

Oct.: Ocean (waves, creatures, etc.)

Nov.: Tan/Brown

Dec.: Red/Orange

For next year, please let me know what kind of fabrics you would like to exchange, or if you would like to keep batiks. Also, let me know if any of you would like to take over this committee, as I'm quite willing to share. This has been a great deal of fun! Cindy Pring

BLOCK OF THE QUARTER, 3RD QUARTER 2015

Thank you for the wonderful participation in the BOQ and fun + beautiful blocks you guys have been bringing me. So fun! Pat Ritchie won our 57 pretty floral blocks (which brought me spring this year) from the 2nd quarter. Congrats to Pat.

Due to popular demand, in our 3rd quarter block of the quarter we will continue using up scraps and leftovers in this simple 9 1/2" "Kismet" block where we can avoid many of the matching seams by spinning the blocks when they are joined together.

We will be using up our bits and pieces IN FALL FABRICS for the July/August/September blocks.

Each Kismet block will require

1-A = 6 1/2" Square

1-B = 3 1/2" Square

2-C = C can be either: 1 piece 3 1/2" X 6 1/2" rectangle OR 2 pieces 3 1/2" each sewn together to 3 1/2" By 6 1/2" OR 4 pieces 2" X 3 1/2" sewn to make one 3 1/2" X 6 1/2" rectangle.

Remember to pin your name to each block, or put an address label on the back for your chances to WIN.
