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Using your Hand-Held Magnifier

- Adjust the distance between the magnifier and the print to obtain a clear focus. The stronger the magnifier, the closer the print will have to be to the magnifier.
- Move the magnifier and the print closer to the eye to obtain a clearer focus and an increased area of viewing. The stronger the magnifier, the closer your eye will have to be to the magnifier.
- Lighting should illuminate the task and not the magnifying lens. Lighting should be placed behind or perpendicular to the task, to avoid glare and reflections.
- Reading may be tiring at first. Start with large print and read only a few minutes at a time. Gradually decrease print size and increase reading time.
- Reading stands may allow improved postural comfort while reading.
- Clean your magnifier with a mild soap (non-alcohol) and water and dry with a soft clean cloth (no Kleenex).
- If your hand-held magnifier is illuminated, good illumination should last (40 hrs.) (70 hrs.) with (2 AA) (3AAA) alkaline batteries. The LED bulbs are "lifetime" and do not have to be replaced.
