1901-1991

Beatrice M. Wollenzien, age 89 of Sheridan Township near Bad Axe, passed away Sunday, Aug. 11 at Four Seasons Health Care Center in Bad Axe after a long illness.

She was born Sept. 4, 1901 in Detroit, daughter of the late Joseph and Mary Simcek. She was united in marriage to Moody H. Wollenzien on Oct. 10, 1925 in Detroit. He preceded her in death Dec. 7, 1989.
