

(UYA) Code Of Conduct

One of the developmental tasks of childhood is to learn appropriate behavior. Children are not born with an innate sense of propriety and they need guidance and direction. The example set by positive adult role models is a powerful tool for shaping behavior and a tool that will be used at UYA Camp.

Physical violence, bullying, cyber bullying (social media), theft and verbal insults have no place in United Youth Aviators (UYA). This conduct will attentively be eliminated.

Youth Aviators

- Respect one another, no name calling, any inappropriate language, or inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated.
- Uplift and encourage each other
- Use words phrases such as: "You can do it," "Do your best," "I will do my best."
- Keep all bodily fluids to yourself. Keep your hands and feet to yourself.
- · Wear the UYA camp shirt, clean and neat.
- Demonstrate respect for all adults in authority.
- Show respect for your surroundings, keep classrooms and inside of aircrafts neat and clean.
- Follow instructions on or off campus of all camp leaders.
- Have strict compliance at airports and during flight.

Misbehavior by a single youth aviator may constitute a threat to the safety of the individual who misbehaves, as well as to the safety of other aviators, instructors, youth counselors, and adult counselors. Youth aviators must be attentive and able to properly respond to supervision, in case of an emergency. Discipline will strongly be implemented.

Violations of these rules, (unless behavior deems extraordinarily unacceptable), will be followed progressively by:

- Verbal correction
- Parental contact of youth aviator
- Request that a parent take the aviator home early
- Expulsion from the camp
