At this time, we have heard from 60 families, about 30% of our parish and have received \$18,817 in contributions. Your gifts help us reach our 2024 goal. Please remember that any amount that is over the goal amount will be returned to our parish for use in our parish project which



is the reroofing of our church. In the past these savings have already given us the funds to resurface and reline our parking areas.


