



## The 2019 William Schatzkamer Young Artists' Competition

**We are delighted to have young talent interested in our competition. We think it is a terrific experience for a serious young artist and we welcome your participation. Please read the rules that we have established and then submit your application.**

### **RULES FOR ENTRY** *\*changes from previous years\**

1. Instrumentalists must be between the ages of 13 and 22 inclusive, vocalists between the ages of 16 through 26 inclusive. Applicants must play classical instruments or be classical vocalists, and perform music composed with orchestral accompaniment from the accepted classical repertoire (one movement for instrumentalists, two selections for vocalists). Total performance time should be approximately 10 minutes.
2. Applicants should perform their selections from memory and provide their own accompanist for the audition. Applicants should bring two copies of their selections for the judges. Previous winners of the competition are not eligible to compete again for three years.
3. The judges will base their decision solely on artistic merit. The number of winners is at the discretion of the judges.
4. Winner(s) will perform in concert with the University City Symphony Orchestra on **Sunday, May 5, 2019** at 3:00 pm at All Saints Catholic Church. The winner must be available to perform and rehearse; failure to adhere to this will result in forfeiting the awards and performance. The Grand Prize Winner will receive a cash scholarship. The amount of the scholarship is to be determined by the donor; UCSO will notify applicants when this information is available. A recording will be made of the performance, which guest artists may use as an audition CD if they wish.
5. Auditions will be held at *\*Thompson House, Webster University, 8282 Big Bend Blvd, St. Louis, MO 63119\**, on **Sunday, March 10, 2019** between 5:00 pm and 9:30 pm. All contestants will be notified of the competition outcome by e-mail within 5 days.
6. Entry fee is \$40.00.
7. Complete application packets, with photo and entry fee, must be received by **March 6, 2019**. *Late registrations will be accepted with a \$10.00 late fee.* Fill out the online form below or print out the application form, complete it, and mail it with your payment to the Orchestra mailing address as it appears on this stationary with the check made payable to the University City Symphony Orchestra.
