



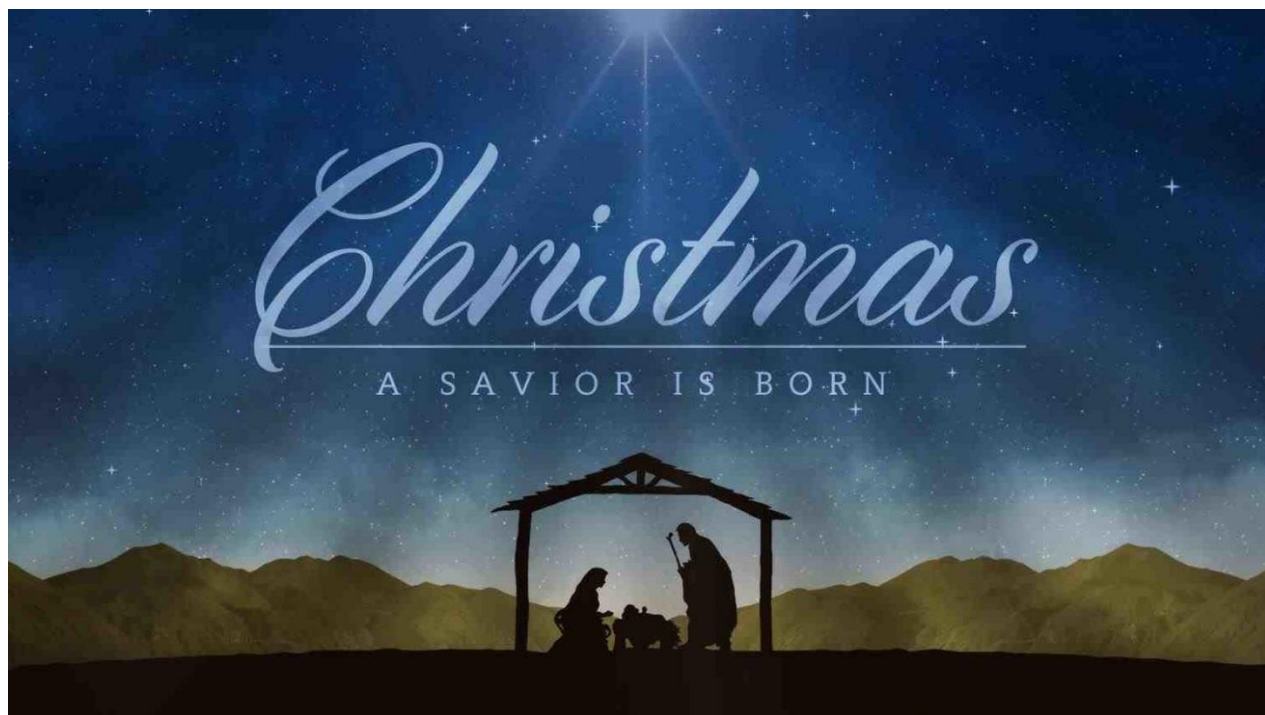

3. Please send a note to your child's teacher (grades K – 4th especially) as we are beginning the year. Sometimes the younger students do not know if they are eating hot lunch or a lunch from home!
