This is the BEST way to actually see the Boston Pops. There are only about 30,000 people in attendance on this night versus upwards of 750,000 on the night of the 4th. The concert is over at around 10pm. (B, D)

## Saturday ♦ Spirit of Boston Luncheon Cruise & Boston Fireworks

Following breakfast this morning, we enjoy a guided riding tour of Harvard University and Cambridge. At 10:30 AM we will arrive at the Spirit of Boston for our 2½ hour luncheon cruise. The special feature of this cruise is that we will follow the USS Constitution for her "once a year" harbor cruise and experience a 21 Gun Salute by her cannons once she reaches Fort Independence.

After our cruise we will visit the JFK Library and Museum which captures the powerful story of the Kennedy years.

Tonight we enjoy a delicious buffet dinner at the Hyatt. Afterwards we can set up our chairs on the bank of the Charles River right next to our hotel where we can hear the Pops playing for the Boston Fireworks Spectacular.

## Thursday ♦ Travel to Boston

Celebrate the 4<sup>th</sup> of July in grand style! ## Friday ♦ Boston Tour & Boston Pops Rehearsal Concert

After an included breakfast, we embark upon a guided riding tour of Boston. Learn about the different districts of the city including the Back Bay where we find so many beautiful brownstones. We will also see Beacon Hill and the gold domed state house, Boston Common, America's first public park and the Public Garden. There are many other famous sites and our tour will cover parts of the Freedom Trail.

We will visit Charlestown Navy Yard run by the National Parks Service and home to the USS Constitution, Old Ironsides. The USS Constitution was launched in Boston on October 21st, 1797 and is the oldest commissioned warship afloat in the world. Today, she is manned by an active duty U.S. Navy Crew.

There is time to visit the Constitution Visitor's Center with memorabilia and gifts and the USS Constitution Museum. Self-guided tours are available of the USS Cassin Young a World War II Navy destroyer.

Lunch today is on our own at Quincy Market. For over 250 years this marketplace has played an integral role in the life of Boston's residents. You will feel the cobblestones beneath your
