The December events will be the Toy Soldier shoot on December 6.





NRA Armed Citizen from November 2025 Magazine

Sept. 10, officers in Austin, Texas, discovered a vehicle that had been reported stolen in a closed park area. The officers split up to patrol the area while one officer waited for a tow truck to remove the vehicle. As the car was being loaded, a man and a woman approached and claimed it was theirs. They began to return to a wooded area as the officer approached them, so he identified himself and ordered them to stop and show their hands. The woman began to comply, but the man reportedly drew a firearm and shot the woman in the head and the officer in the abdomen. The officer returned fire, but the suspect was able to flee. He was spotted a few hours later near a school, and the school's security officer attempted to detain him, but the man continued to run. Officers soon located him again, but the suspect then allegedly broke into a private residence by kicking open the front door. An armed citizen in the home fired two shots at the suspect, striking him once in the arm and once in the leg, whereupon officers were finally able to detain him. He was in the hospital in stable condition at the time of reporting and faced numerous charges. The officer was treated for his injuries; the woman was pronounced braindead at the hospital. <u>Anti-Gun Candidates</u> Clean Sweep in Off-Year Election

Big-name national gun-control organizations with deep pockets spent large to help pull off wins for their candidates and issues at the polls on Tuesday.

These elections impact lawabiding gun owners up and down the East Coast, where Americans' Second Amendment rights have long been under siege from anti-gun politicians and gun control advocates.

Virginia, former U.S. Rep. Abigail Spanberger (D) defeated Republican Lt. Gov. Winsome Earle-Sears to flip the polarity of the state's Governor's Mansion starting in 2026. Spanberger, 46, a former CIA officer, represented the Old Dominion state's Beltway area 7th Congressional District from 2019 to 2025, where she was a reliable vote for gun control on Capitol Hill.

New Jersey, U.S. Rep. Mikie Sherrill (D), currently in her fourth term in Congress, beat Republican opponent Jack Ciattarelli, a former state legislator endorsed by Trump. Sherrill, who sits on the House Gun Violence Prevention Task Force, has been outspoken in her support of stricter nationwide gun control while in Congress.

Following Gun Industry Spotlight, Major Bank Changes Tune

Not one full day after NSSF – the Firearm Industry Trade Association – spotlighted a major financial institution continuing its policy of discriminating against a lawful and highly regulated firearm industry business, the bank has changed its tune.

The discrimination was laid bare in a short, direct email from a J.P. Morgan Wealth Management advisor to Brandon Maddox, Founder and CEO of Silencer Central – a firearm suppressor company – denying services when Maddox inquired if the banking giant works with companies in the firearm industry. One day later, a very senior executive from J.P. Morgan Wealth Management reached back out to Silencer Central to explain that they do, in fact, want to do business, according to emails shared with NSSF.

Trust, but verify. The firearm industry thanks J.P. Morgan Wealth Management for their quick corrective action in reaching out to Silencer Central. But we will be watching to ensure those conversations are meaningful and that no banking services are denied to the industry that provides Americans with the means of exercising their Second Amendment rights.
