Mazyck-Wraggborough Neighborhood Association Notes November 14, 2016

Our November meeting was held at on November 14th at 6:30 P.M. at St. Stephen's Episcopal Church. First on the agenda was a presentation by Harry Lesesne, Executive Director of Charleston Parks Conservancy. He has been with the service for 4 years and discussed the 3rd park he is now working on in our neighborhood. In the past he has directed the work on Chapel Street Fountain Park, Tiedemann Park and now the Wragg Square. The city has put \$215,000 into the project in the new steps and handicapped access. Phase 2 will consist of working on the front 1/3 of the park. It will have a "plant" fountain centered with a Grecian urn. Both Michael Bennet and Netflix contributed generously to help get the work done. To date, money promised from The Dewberry property has not been forthcoming.

Nancy Snowdon was not present to discuss her plans for her business to be run from her newly purchased property at 20 Charlotte, but our President, Vangie, said it will be a "benign" presence.

The owner of 21 Charlotte St appeared with her architect to discuss adding 4 new residential units in 3 structures to the rear of her property. They do not need any variances as the zoning is in place and they are providing more parking than is required.
